

# What's in my range bag?



The best range bag is one that holds all that you need but is not overwhelming in size and weight



## A gun pouch or case



This allows you to transport your pistol from the safety table to the firing line and protects your firearm from imperfections on the bench.

## Ammo, magazines & speed loaders

Enough correct ammunition for your range time; extra magazines and a speed loader to move things along.



# Eye & Ear Protection



The best hearing protection is achieved by combining ear muffs with plugs.

## Eye Protection: The colors

Amber: works best in low light conditions or on a cloudy day;

Vermillion: excellent for shooting against a green background;

Clear: preferred on both indoor and outdoor ranges; and

Gray: best for shooting outdoors in bright sun.

# Baseball Cap or Visor

Wear while shooting to deflect hot brass which is extremely hot and can cause burns.



In the event of a malfunction or a problem with your handgun, you can be prepared. Also keep your gun's owner's manual handy for quick reference if a problem arises.
