



## Binding & Loosing

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) As an ambassador of **Christ** (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in **Christ** (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), **Jesus Christ**, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that **Christ** might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well-being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2) In the name of **Jesus Christ**, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), , and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that **Christ**, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord **Jesus Christ**. (1 Cor. 15:57)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in

heaven bless you and your house and keep you (Num. 6:24). Glory to God the Father! (Luke 2:14) We don't come to the Father based on our own worthiness or on the worthiness of you and your family, but by **Jesus Christ**, whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loose. (John 1:27) As a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come before God's mercy seat on the merits of His Son, **Jesus Christ**, and the precious blood that He shed (1 Pet. 1:19); for worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev 5:12)! In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 2:20), abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come boldly to the throne of grace that you may obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for you and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, and from **Jesus Christ**, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved you and washed you from your sins in His own blood, and has made you kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. (Rev. 1:4-6) Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of **Jesus** our Lord, as His divine power has given to you all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called you by glory and virtue, by which have been given to you exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. (2 Pet. 1:2-4) And we know that the Son of God has come and has given you an understanding, that you may know Him who is true; and you are in Him who is true, in His Son **Jesus Christ**. This is the true God and eternal life. (1 John 5:20) He is the Rock, His work is perfect; for all His ways are justice, a God of truth and without injustice; righteous and upright is He. (Deut. 32:4)

The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears, and delivers us out of all our troubles. (Ps. 34:17) Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the Lord our God. (Ps. 20:7) In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who sits at the right hand of the Majesty on high (Heb. 1:3), as a

fellow worker in **Christ**, abiding in **Christ** (John 15:4-5) and Him in us (John 6:56, John 15:5), we bind you (Matt. 16:19), Satan, according to Ephesians 6:12. In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), **Jesus Christ**, we break Satan's powers (Luke 10:19) over you and your family. As a vessel of mercy, so that **Christ** might make known to you the riches of His glory, we loose (Matt. 16:19) you and your family from his (Satan's) hold and destroy his works (1 John 3:8-9) and his assignment in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10). As an ambassador of **Christ** (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in **Christ** (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 17:22) we speak to you, Satan, in the mighty and precious name of **Jesus** of Nazareth (John 16:23), declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:3). Abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), in the precious name of our savior, **Jesus Christ**, we take authority (Luke 10:19) and bind (Matt. 16:19) all demonic spirits assigned to you and your family. Our Lord **Jesus Christ** has given us authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy and nothing shall by any means hurt us. (Luke 10:19) In Him who is true, **Jesus Christ**, in His mighty name, we take authority over all the power of the enemy over you and your house and command that nothing shall grow from it ever again, it shall wither away just as the fig tree withered away when **Jesus** cursed it in Matt. 21:19. In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb 10:21), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22) we bind (Math 16:19) the spirits of doubt (Matt. 14:31), deception (Rom. 1:29), **control and seduction , manipulation, intimidation, domination, bondage** (Rom. 8:15), destruction (Rom. 3:16), idleness or laziness, gossip (1 Tim. 5:13), revelry, drunkenness, lewdness (Rom. 13:13), unrighteousness, sexual immorality, vile (Rom. 1:26)passion (Col. 3:5), wickedness, strife, evil mindedness, violence, boasting, disobedience (Rom. 1:29-31), anger, bitterness, wrath, clamor, resentment, malice, evil speaking (Eph. 4:31), filthy language(Col. 3:8) jealousy, envy (Gal. 5:21), **possessiveness, perceived injury, indignation** (Rom. 2:8), **guilt** (Heb. 10:22), condemnation (Rom. 5:16, 8:1), division (Rom. 16:17), **lies** (Acts 5:3, Eph. 4:24), **self righteousness (false humility)** (Col. 2:23), **fear** (Rom. 8:15), **mockery, abuse, meanness, unkindness** (1 Cor. 13:4),**discouragement, depression, suicide, insanity** (Rom. 1:28), **conceit, rudeness, self seeking** (1 Cor. 13:5), (James 3:14) **selfishness** (2 Cor. 12:20, 2 Tim. 3:2)), **mammon** (Luke 16:11), **loving money** (2 Tim. 3:2), **idolatry** (1 Cor. 10:14), **evil desires** (Col. 3:5) **boasting, disobedience, blasphemy, un-thankfulness, slander, brutality, treachery, pleasure seeking** (2 Tim. 3:3-4),

foolishness (Rom. 1:22), futile thoughts, day dreaming (Jude 1:8) (Rom. 1:21), pride (Rom. 1:30), **covetous ()**, **greed**, **gluttony**, adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousy, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, backbiting, whispering, conceit, tumult (2 Cor. 12:20) dissension's, heresies, murder, kidnapping, perjury, sodomy (1 Tim 1:10), drunkenness, revelries (Gal. 5:19-21) stealing (Eph. 4:28), corrupting (Eph. 4:29), foolish talking (Eph. 5:4), coarse jesting (Eph. 5:4), lawlessness, insubordination, profanity (1 Tim. 1:9), flattery, licentiousness (2 Pet. 2:18) and lusts of the flesh (2 Peter 2:18), the lust of the eye and the pride of life (1 John 2:16) and all unnamed evil (Luke 7:21), wicked (Ps. 12:8) or unclean spirits (Luke 8:29). As God's fellow worker (1 Cor. 3:9), in **Christ** we bind (Math 16:19) the arrogant, pompous (1 Cor. 13:4), busy body (1 Tim. 5:13), provoking, evil thinking (1 Cor. 13:5), undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful (Rom. 1:31), unholy (2 Tim. 3:3-4) critical (), judgemental (Rom. 2:1), defiling (Rev. 21:27) headstrong, and haughty spirits (2 Tim. 3:3-4) as well. As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), in **Christ** we bind all spirits that cause you to lack self-control (2 Tim. 3:3-4) or be haters of God, inventors of evil things (Rom. 1:29-31), or dispisers of good (2 Tim. 3:3-4). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), in the mighty name of **Jesus Christ**, **Christ**, Him being in us and we being in **Christ**, we bind (Math 16:19) the religious spirit (self-imposed religion) (Col. 2:23), having a form of godliness but denying its power (2 Tim. 3:5), as well as the antichrist spirit (1 John 2:18) and all unnamed demonic spirits that causes an abomination or a lie (Rev. 21:27). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord **Christ Jesus**. (1 Cor. 15:57) Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all. (1 Chr. 29:11)

In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask Father God, in the name of His beloved son, **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the author and finisher of your faith (Heb. 12:2), to help you and your family tear down all strongholds that empower wicked, unclean or evil spirits, casting down arguments, imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of **Christ**, and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled (2 Cor. 10:4-6). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will turn to the Lord, that the veil is taken away from your hearts (2 Cor. 3:16); and you and your people are given an

ear to hear what the spirit says (Rev. 2:7); and your eyes are anointed with eye salve so that you may see clearly (Rev. 3:18). Our Lord, the Lord of hosts, is a crown of glory and a diadem of beauty! He is a spirit of justice to him who sits in judgment, and He is strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate. (Is. 28:5-6) Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, The Lord mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you gates! And lift them up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, He is the King of glory. Selah (Ps. 24:7-10)

As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we command Satan to loose (Matt. 16:19) you and your family and let you go free in the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we demand that Satan and his demonic hoard stop their maneuvers, their schemes, their tricks, their designs, their devices (2 Cor. 2:11) against you and your people, for you are the children of God (1 John 3:1). You and your family are covered by the blood of Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 1:19), the precious Lamb slain for you (John 1:29), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29). The voice of the Lord makes the deer give birth, and strips the forests bare; and in His temple everyone says, "Glory!" The Lord sat enthroned at the Flood, and the Lord sits as King forever. The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace. (Ps. 29:9-11)

Thank You, Father, you have given to us the keys to the kingdom of heaven, and whatever we bind on earth, shall be bound in heaven, and whatever we loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. (Matt.8:18) In Jesus' name (John 16:23), all things are under His feet (Eph. 1:22), Christ abiding in us (John 15:4-5, 6:56), we bind (Matt. 16:19) and break off of you and your family all principalities, powers, rulers of darkness of this world, and spiritual wickedness in high places (Eph. 6:12), all occult activity -- curses (Duet. 23:4-5), spells (Duetl 18:10) witchcraft, soothsaying (Duet. 18:10), divination (Lev. 19:26) and sorcery (Duet. 18:10). May the Lord your God turn every curse into a blessing for you and your house, for the Lord your God loves you and your people (Duet. 23:5). In the precious name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who has authority over all

flesh (John 17:2), as an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5) we bind the kings of evil with chains, and the nobles of evil with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment - this honor have all His saints. (Ps. 149:8-9) In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), and by the authority of Jesus Christ, from God and sent by God (John 7:29), as a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ (Acts 9:15), to bear His name, we destroy the works (1 John 3:8) of the enemy over you and your family, and come against any soul power (Luke 10:19) or emotional ties that do not glorify our Lord Jesus Christ. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. (1 John 3:8) He is fairer than the sons of men; grace is poured upon His lips; therefore God has blessed Him forever. Gird Your sword upon Your thigh, O Mighty One, with Your glory and Your majesty. And in Your majesty ride prosperously because of truth, humility, and righteousness; and Your right hand shall teach You awesome things. Your arrows are sharp in the heart of our enemies. Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. You, Lord Jesus, love righteousness and hate wickedness; therefore God, our God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness. All Your garments are scented with myrrh and aloes and cassia, out of the ivory palaces, by which they made You glad. (Ps. 45:2-8) The Lord of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah (Ps. 46:7)

Demons, listen well. In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we declare, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), for God created all things through Jesus Christ (Eph. 3:9), You and your family are the children of the God Most High (Gen. 14:18, Rom 8:16) You and your people are covered by the blood of Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 1:19), your Lord and Savior. You and yours have a blood covenant relationship with the God Most High (Gen. 14:18, 1 Cor 11:25), the Lord God of hosts (2 Sam. 5:10). Your bodies and your minds are the temple of the living God (1 Cor. 3:16), the Most High God (Gen. 14:18), the Lord God of hosts (2 Sam.5:10), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Alpha and the Omega (Rev. 1:8), the Creator of all things (Gen. 1:1), the only true God (John 17:3) and the Spirit of God dwells within you (1 Cor 3:16) and His banner covers your house (Ex. 17:15). If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are. (1 Cor. 3:17). Christ, through us, we take authority and command all demons not to defile this temple, which you are, in any manner or by any means. In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our

Father, in the name of the son of His love (), **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), to fill this temple, which you are, with His Holy Spirit and make it Holy ground. (1 Cor. 3:17) Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in your hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to you. (Rom. 5:5) May the fruits of the Spirit, which are love, joy, peace, patience, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control be manifested (Gal. 5:22) in your daily life. Be still, and know God; He will be exalted among the nations, He will be exalted in the earth! The Lord of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah (Ps. 46:10-11)

God abiding in us, and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we pray in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), I AM (John 8:58), that you and your family will continue in the faith firmly established and steadfast, grounded and settled, and that you not be moved away from the hope of the gospel which you have heard. (Col. 1:23) Let Jehovah-Mekoddishkem, the Lord who sanctifies you, sanctify you and your house in His truth; His Word is truth. (John 17:15-17) Let Jehovah-Raah guide you with his counsel and afterward receive you to glory. (Ps. 73:23-24) Let Jehovah-Tsidkenu bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as a light and your justice as the noonday. (Ps. 37:6) Let Jehovah-Jireh provides all your needs according to His riches in glory by **Christ Jesus** (Phil. 4:19). Let Jehovah-Sabaoth deliver you from destructions. (Ps. 103:4) Let Jehovah-Rapha heal you of your diseases (Ps. 103:3), bind up your wounds, and heal your broken hearts (Ps. 147:3) and let the peace of Jehovah-Shalom guard your hearts and minds through **Christ Jesus**. (Phil. 4:7). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will know without doubting that Jehovah-Shammah will never leave you or forsake you. (Heb. 13:5) Our Lord and Savior, **Jesus Christ**, will be with you always, even to the end of the age. (Matt. 28:20) Thanks be to Jehovah-Nissi who gives you victory through the Lord **Jesus Christ**. (1 Cor. 15:57) Because **Jesus** keeps you and your people safe, the wicked one cannot touch you. (1 John 5:18) For the Lord Most High is awesome; He is a great King over all the earth. (Ps. 47:2)

Whatever we loose on Earth, will be loosed in heaven (Matt. 18:18), therefore we loose the angels, the ministering spirits, to minister to your every need (Heb. 1:14). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we beseech God to give His angels charge over you to keep you in all your ways (Ps. 91:11) In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we loose the

blessings of the covenant over you and your family (Acts 3:25). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we loose the blessings of Deut. 28 over you and your people. Let all these blessings come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God. (Deut. 28:2). Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country. Blessed shall be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground and the increase of your herds, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks. Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl. Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out. The Lord will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways. The Lord will command the blessing on you in your storehouses and in all to which you set your hand, and He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God is giving you. The Lord will establish you as a holy people to Himself, just as He has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the Lord your God and walk in His ways. Then all peoples of the earth shall see that you are called by the name of the Lord, and they shall be afraid of you. And the Lord will grant you plenty of goods, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your ground, in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you. The Lord will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many, but you shall not borrow. And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God. (Deut. 28:3-13) Oh, how great is Your goodness, Which You have laid up for those who fear You, Which You have prepared for those who trust in You In the presence of the sons of men! (Ps. 31:19) Blessed is the family whose God is the Lord, and the people whom He has chosen as His own inheritance. The Lord looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men. From the place of His habitation He looks on all the inhabitants of the earth; He fashions their hearts individually; He considers all their works. (Ps. 33:12-15) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the Lord God will remember you and your house with the favor He has toward His people. That you and your family may see the benefit of His salvation, that you and your people see the benefit of His chosen ones, that you may rejoice in the gladness of His nation, that you and yours glory with His

inheritance. (Ps. 106:4-5) Blessed be the Lord, who daily loads you with benefits, the God of your salvation! (Ps. 68:19)

Lord, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that your will now be done (Matt. 6:10), and we thank you. In Jesus' name, who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10) and by His authority, which He has given to us (Luke 10:19), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we declare it done. Thank you, Lord, for watching over Your Word to perform it. (Jer 1:12) We have thought, O God, on Your lovingkindness, In the midst of Your temple. According to Your name, O God, so is Your praise to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of righteousness. (Ps. 48:9-10)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not

sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards you and your house are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). We ask our Father in heaven in the name of our Lord ***Jesus Christ*** (John 16:23), the Lord our redemer (Gal. 4:5), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9) for it is written "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8) The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him void but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) In ***Jesus'*** name (John 16:23) so be it. You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) "Moab is plundered and gone up from her cities; Her chosen young men have gone down to the slaughter," says the King, whose name is the Lord of hosts. (Jer. 48:15) We shall eat in plenty and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord our God, who has dealt wondrously with us; and we, His people, shall never be put to shame. (Joel 2:26) But to us who fear His name the Sun of Righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings; and we shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. (Mal. 4:2) For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
