Hydrangea serrata 'Tuff Stuff' -

This plant delivers on both accounts. Its attractive, reddish-pink lacecap flowers create a mass of color in early summer, and it continues to produce new flowers right up until frost. The semi-double to double florets begin with creamy coloration in the center



Hydrangea pan. 'Quickfire' #3

Quick Fire blooms about a month before other Hardy Hydrangea varieties and flowers every year! Flowers open white then turn pink as summer progresses. This very hardy flowering shrub is perfect in mixed containers, mass plantings, as a hedge, or cut flower.



Hydrangea Limelight #7— BUDDING

This unique panicle hydrangea revolutionized landscaping across North America. Huge, football-shaped flowers.



Hydrangea "Endless Summer"

#3— A Bigleaf Hydrangea plant with flowers that form on the current year's growth as well as on old wood. Endless Summer® can bloom for months in warm areas, especially if deadheaded regularly, and the flower heads—blue on acid soils, pink on alkaline—BUD/BLOOM!

Hemerocallis 'Stella D'oro #1 & #2

New leaves emerge bright gold and mature to a peachy orange. Soft but showy color adds warmth and contrast to mixed containers and woodland borders. Thrives in the high heat and humidity of the South. Sun tolerant in cool northern gardens

Miscanthus Gracillimus #7

'Gracillimus', known as maiden grass, is noted for its narrow green leaves with a silver midrib which form a substantial, rounded, arching clump of foliage typically growing 4-6' tall (to 8' when in flower). Foliage turns yellowish after frost, but quickly fades to straw-beige by winter.



Liatris- #1 & #2 — ABOUT TO BLOOM

'Kobold' is a small, compact, upright, cultivar which typically grows 2-2.5' tall
