

**Minutes of Regular Meeting

September 14, 2020**

- The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township trustees was held on Monday, September 14, 2020 in the shop behind the township building. Bill Siegel, township trustee chairperson, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. He stated the meeting is being recorded, and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Roll call was taken with the following answering as present: Bill Siegel, Bill Bogantz and Dave Cole.
- Bill Bogantz made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 10, 2020, regular trustee meeting. Dave Cole seconded the motion and it passed with all YES votes.

**Resident/Public Input**

- William Bollinger requested input on zoning and possible violation at 7059 Dutch Lane. Ed Wasem, Zoning Inspector, addressed the issue and it was discussed with the trustees.

**Old Business**

- Roads – tar & chip is done. Denunes Road work will begin in 1-2 weeks. Salt has been delivered for the winter.

**New Business**

- The trash bids were opened.
  - Kimble - \$18.28 per resident; \$16.45 for seniors; \$3.50 for tote rental.
  - Rumpke - \$16.56 per resident; \$14.90 for seniors; \$3.50 for tote rental.

- Waste Management - \$16.75 per resident (includes tote); \$15.08 for seniors (includes tote); tote rental no charge; 4% annual increase.
  - Waste Away - \$15.45 per resident; \$13.90 for seniors; \$3.00 for tote rental.
- Bill Siegel made a motion to accept the bid from Waste Management assuming legal counsel oks it. Bill Bogantz seconded the motion. The motion passed with all YES votes.
  - The trustees discussed fence for the Liberty Church Cemetery. Bill Bogantz made a motion to have Mae Fencing install a fence costing \$11,950.00 Bill Siegel seconded the motion. The motion passed with all YES votes. A 50% deposit is required for work to begin.
  - Resolution 06-2020 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the budget commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the county auditor was briefly discussed. Bill Siegel made a motion to accept the resolution. Dave Cole seconded the motion. It passed with all YES votes.
  - The township's rental property was discussed. The tenants are riding a 4-wheeler around the adjacent field. Melodie will get Bill Siegel a Holds Harmless form to have the tenants sign.
  - There was discussion about hearing that Timber Creek residents have blocked the road so that kids can ride 4 wheelers, bikes and skateboard on the road. This is a safety concern.
  - The trustees agreed to have the October meeting in-person in the shop.





**August Credit Card charges were read totaling \$339.71**
