PNWPWDC is accepting online entries for this trial through the AKC Agility Online Entry Services. Go to www.akc.org/AqilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% (220 runs) Paper entries: 67% (440 runs). If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 26" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES

Classes Offered

All levels of Standard STD, JWW, FAST, T2B and Premier, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Move-ups and Errors

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by <u>6</u> <u>pm, Pacific time, Monday, March 13, 2017</u>. Requests for move-ups over the phone <u>will not be accepted.</u> Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to a Novice "B" class.

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Height Divisions

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all *regular classes:*

8″	for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class: 4"

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all international classes (if offered):

- for dogs 13-3/4 inches and under at the withers (mini dogs) 18" for dogs 16-7/8 inches and under at the withers (midi dogs) 26" for dogs over 16-7/8 inches at the withers (maxi dogs)

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/26" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/26" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the needs measurement box if your dog needs to be measured so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the *Dogs To Be* Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. For complete details on the Jump Height Card Process go to www.k-9sports.com and click on the link on the Events page.

AWARDS, RIBBONS AND PRIZE INFORMATION

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

PNWPWDC offers an embroidered throw for High Scoring Portuguese Water Dog on Saturday.

We will be offering a Rosette to the High in Trial dog (Combined YPS from the Regular Standard and JWW classes) with a title from any other AKC Companion Event (Rally, Obedience, Tracking) on Saturday, March 18th. It will be up to the exhibitor to let us know that they are eligible for this award. Details will be at the event. The award will be announced on Sunday morning.

B MATCH

Thirty minutes after the trial ends on Saturday, there will be a B match. A B Match runs exactly like a show, but with no scoring. You may use toys and you can train in the ring. There will be a time limit per run of 90 seconds. The cost is \$5.00 per run. You must fill out an entry form and entries will be taken day of show. The dog does not have to be entered in the show to run in the match. Dogs must be 15 months of age or older to enter.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a written request is received by the event secretary on or before the trial closing date. After closing, refunds will be given, if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial, less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs. 100% refund for bitches in season.
