In today's Gospel we see Jesus in full public ministry. As he heals the woman "who had been suffering from hemorrhages for twelve years" and as he raises back to life the young daughter of one of the elders of the local synagogue, Jesus shows himself to be the Lord of life and death. Today, Jesus invites us to a faith which transcends present suffering and future death. In the unfolding of the two miracles in today's Gospel, we are led to see the importance of such faith – faith in the healing power of Jesus and faith in the resurrection and eternal life. Today, let us offer a fervent prayer of thanksgiving to God for the faith we have been given and pray that this faith will remain alive in our hearts. Jesus invites us to embrace that faith, confident that our lives are in the hands of our loving God and "in the sure and certain hope that, together with all who have died in Christ, we will rise with him on the last day".



**JUNE 30 - DEDICATION OF IMMACULATE CONCEPTION  
CATHEDRAL, GRAND FALLS-WINDSOR**

Transferred from June 29, the anniversary of the cathedral dedication is celebrated as a feast throughout the diocese and as a proper solemnity in the cathedral parish. The importance of the cathedral church in the liturgical life of the diocese flows from the role of the Bishop as high priest of the Lord's flock. Every parish community is related to the Bishop, and therefore the anniversary of the cathedral church's dedication as a place of worship is celebrated throughout the diocese.

**JULY 1 - CANADA DAY:** July 1, Canada's birthday, is a special day of prayer in Canada. As Canadian Christians, we should seek to be witnesses to Christ in Canada and the world, and we should work to influence those in government to act from Christian principles and attitudes. Knowing that we do not have a lasting home here on earth, we should pray and work for justice and peace in Canada and throughout the world, so that all God's people may share in the goods of this earth, realizing that God's kingdom will come only when all people are ready to let Christ's teaching guide and rule our lives and actions. On this day, we are also encouraged to pray for our leaders and to consider our responsibilities as Canadian citizens.

**July 3 - Feast of Saint Thomas, Apostle:** Since the days of the early Church, there has been a tradition that Thomas is the Apostle of India. Although the phrase "doubting Thomas" refers to him, it overlooks both his loyalty in troubled times and his absolute surrender when given the evidence he sought. Having seen, he became the believer and declared the great Christian confession: "My Lord and my God". Thomas is the patron saint of builders and of India and Pakistan.

**July 4 - Memorial of Saint Elizabeth of Portugal:** Elizabeth led a disciplined life of prayer and good works, caring for the poor and the sick. After her husband's death in 1325, she gave up her rank and wealth for a life of simplicity and joined the Poor Clares. She died on July 4, 1336. Canonized in 1625, Elizabeth is a patroness of Catholic charities.

**July 5 - Memorial of Saint Anthony Zaccaria, Priest:** Anthony was born in Cremona, Italy, in 1502. Both a physician and a priest, he was greatly inspired by Saint Paul. Anthony was the founder of the Clerks Regular of Saint Paul, also known as the Barnabites. He encouraged the laity to work with the clergy in helping the poor and also promoted the frequent reception of Holy Communion. Anthony died in 1539 and was canonized in 1897.

**July 6 - Memorial of Saint Maria Goretti, Virgin, Martyr:** At the age of 12, Maria was assaulted by an 18-year old neighbour, Alessandro. She chose death, rather than yield to his demands. She was stabbed several times and died the following day, having forgiven him. Maria was canonized in 1950 by Pope Pius XII for her defence of Christian virtue. She is a patron of young women.
