Faith will strengthen us. Our request to God is to preserve and protect our Armenian land. May our prayer be engaging, so that we may stand as protector of our native homeland, the precious inheritance entrusted to us by our forefathers.

VOTING MEMBERSHIP

If you are not yet a <u>voting</u> member of the St. Mary Yettem Parish, you might want to consider membership. Some might ask what constitutes "membership in our church".

If you tell others, you are a "member of St. Mary Armenian Church in Yettem" it is understood that you have an allegiance to our church. That means you have a loyalty to attending here in Yettem. That usually also includes that you support the parish by your attendance and your physical and/or monetary contributions to her well-being.

"Voting Membership" takes this membership to another level. Voting membership is available to any member of the church that is at least eighteen years of age and who has been baptized or chrismated in the Armenian Church. It signifies a higher commitment to attend an annual meeting to be included in the decisions to keep our church strong and to *possibly* hold an elected position. A voting member also pays an annual dues as part of their pledge. The number of voting members we have determines how many delegates we have at the diocesan level.

2024 Annual Stewardship Pledge Drive





Dear Parishioners,

The easiest way to understand the concept of *Stewardship* is in terms of accepting responsibility for caring for our Church. From a biblical point of view, stewardship is all-inclusive. It touches every area of life, including our time and talent as well as our treasure. Stewardship is faithfully using whatever God gives us in the way of opportunities, interests, skills, employment, family, talents, spiritual gifts, land and yes - our money.

There is no better Biblical guidance for how to give and share of our *financial* resources through the church than some words of the Apostle Paul. In 2 Corinthians Paul expresses encouragement and gratitude to the Christians in Corinth, because they were freely giving their resources to support their poor brothers and sisters elsewhere. In the midst of these words, he shares:

Everyone should give whatever they have decided in their heart. They shouldn't give with hesitation or because of pressure. God loves a cheerful giver. (2 Cor. 9:7)

Your regular financial gifts are necessary to the life of our church. Toward the end of each year our church's Parish Council is responsible for creating the next year's budget. To be wise stewards of the resources that we share together, we create a balanced (or mostly balanced) budget based on anticipated income. The primary means of determining our anticipated income is through pledges. It is with the use of this attached pledge form that we obtain such information.

Our proposed annual budget for 2024 is approximately \$220,000. The monthly operational cost for St. Mary Armenian Church of Yettem will be approximately \$18,300. The ability to meet the expenses comes in part from your generosity. There are numerous ways to choose to fulfill your pledge from giving annually, semi-annually, quarterly, monthly, or weekly. All of your Stewardship Pledge goes to St. Mary Armenian Church of Yettem to pay on-going expenses. It helps us meet the budgetary needs of our parish like paying salaries, maintaining our buildings and grounds, responding to your sacramental and pastoral needs, funding liturgical needs and educational programs and helping us keep in touch with you. Your Stewardship Pledge goes directly to the St. Mary Church general fund.

We humbly ask that you search your heart in determining what you are comfortably able to pledge for the coming year and to complete the enclosed form and **return by December 8, 2023**, to help us plan.
