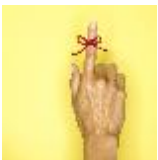

Sunday Services Committee: Monthly meetings at the church at 7 p.m. on the first Tuesday of the month.

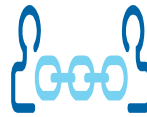
