

Study Skills Summer Course

Does your student need help getting organized and preparing for tests?

Is your student feeling overwhelmed about balancing school work and activities at STM?

The High School of Saint Thomas More is offering a Study Skills course this summer to prepare students to tackle these tasks.

The Study Skills course at The High School of Saint Thomas More aids in the transition from grade school to high school and prepares incoming students and current Freshmen for academic and extra-curricular life at STM. **Because over 92% of students at STM participate in at least one extra-curricular activity, a course that prepares students to use their time wisely and stay organized is in high demand.**

The course covers a wide range of topics including important information about student life at STM, organization, time management, note taking, listening for meaning, study skills, and appropriate use of technology. A major emphasis is placed on helping students adopt an organized approach to studying and reducing test anxiety.

Students who complete the summer course will receive a 1/2 elective credit towards graduation at Saint Thomas More. In order to receive the 1/2 elective credit, students must attend ALL sessions or arrange to make up missed sessions. If this is not possible, students may take the course for their own benefit but will not receive the 1/2 elective credit.

The 2017 course will be held July 31-August 10 (Monday through Thursday) from 2:30-4:00 and will be taught by Krista Hinkley, an English teacher at The High School of Saint Thomas More. The cost of the course is \$110, which covers all materials for the course.
