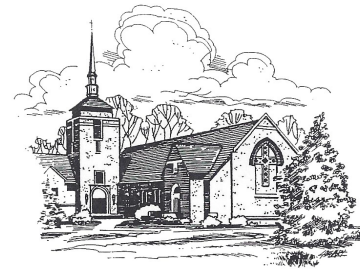

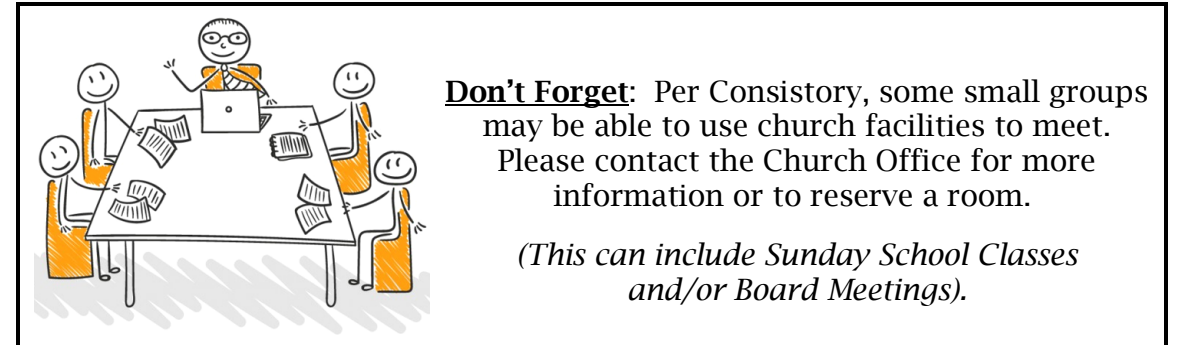

of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

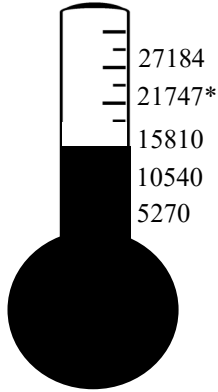

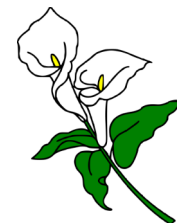
