



GOT SKUNK?

This formula was developed by William F. Wood, a chemist at Humboldt State University in California.

Many thanks to him~ I wonder if he knows what people are using his magic for? J

1 Quart 3% hydrogen peroxide
¼ cup baking soda
1 teaspoon liquid soap or dish detergent

Bathe the dog with the mixture, after 5 minutes rinse with warm water. Repeat if necessary (and it likely will be!)

The mixture should be mixed immediately before using as it does not store well. If you try to store the leftovers, please do so in something other than a glass container! The mixture releases oxygen gas and it could break the glass. I am told that dark coated dogs have been known to look “bleached” after treatment, though I have not experienced this myself. Coats grow back though, so don’t panic!

I have also used this mixture with great success on cat urine areas in the home and on furniture. It has not bleached my carpets or furniture, but please try a spot not easily seen before you try a larger area.
