Jerry Simmonowitz, KB2GCG spoke about "FT8 and More".

Digital operating almost exclusively on FT8. This presentation is a practical operating guide, not a technical guide.

FT8 is not just a mode oar a singular program (WSJT-X). It's a set of tools. Also, it is not a low power mode.

FT8 can be run with a low cost computer, a sound card, and free or low-cost software.

WSJT-X has a variety of modes.

JT65 is used for EME.

JT9 is similar to JT65

Both have a 60 second transmit/receive timing.

FT8 is four times faster and a little less sensitive. Transmit/ Receive is 15 seconds, with a -24dB threshold.

FT8 works with a waterfall.

JT65, JT9, and PSK31 have all but disappeared.

The FT8 "Ecosystem

- Base tool: WSJT-X program
- Meinberg- critical for accurate timing.
- JT-Alert- a free option and supplemental program which is also a bridge to other logging programs.
- HRD- for rig control. This program is not free, and contains rig control and logging.
- PSK Reporter- a reporting website. It lets you know where your signals are being heard.
- QRZ- call sign lookup.
- Analyzer
- Bandconditions.com is an indicator of what's happening on the bands.

There are hundreds of free tools out there.

Use the tools to understand the band picture, etc., and look at your ham radio as a system.

External sound card – Rig Blaster.

Software automates the QSO. It always operates split.
