VALENTINE'S DAY PARTIES AT BHPCNS




Valentine's Day Parties will be held on:

MCPS elementary schools need to know if your child will be attending their school in September 2017. To register your child, call your local elementary school. It is very helpful to the elementary schools to know the number of children attending for next fall as soon as possible. Based on projected enrollments your child's elementary school may need to add another class, add another teacher, increase class size, and/or close a class. While your child won't start school until September the elementary schools are already making their staffing projections for the fall.

STAY AND PLAY UPDATES



Monday: The Artist's Corner By Mrs. McCullough

Using the toy of the year, an air marker sprayer, we will be crafting a negative transfer snowflake project. On the second Monday we'll string up a sweet Valentine gift. Our artists will miss class on Presidents' Day, and on the last Monday of the month a Monet garden will start blooming.

The underlying theme in January was opposites. We learned about convection by watching how heat moved from a hot place to a cold place. The next week, our topic was air pressure. We pushed a hard-boiled, peeled egg into a glass bottle using only a match and a piece of paper generating two opposing pressurized environments. The third week we learned about static electricity and its positive and negative charges. We had fun with balloons, tissue paper and pencils to demonstrate this theory. In February, our cubs will turn into penny wizards. We will compare a new penny with an old one and discuss how the oxide is formed. We then will use several household items to clean these pennies. The rest of the month will be all about the senses and show how much we rely on them and how we use them simultaneously without even knowing it.




Thursday: Where in the World is Bradley Bear? By Mrs. Cardoni

Music with Mr. Chip 2s, 3s, & 4s

Mr. Chip Reports:

As January's weather demonstrated, things never go exactly as you plan! We had a wonderful time in music class this month and are poised to continue our journey into books and music. In February we will sing and move to a favorite book by Eric Carle and explore many ways to move with and without streamers while we sing "Jim Along Josie," an infectious tune that lends itself to a lot of creative movements! We will discover some instruments that make a twinkle sound as well as some ways to move and twinkle in the stars. I will also bring back my drums for a rousing play along to Twinkle Twinkle Little Star (my secret jazzy version) and teach a new way to improve listening while dancing to Ring Around the Rosie. It promises to be another fun filled and busy month in music class!

Mrs. Sutherland Reports:

We'll be taking a lot of deep breaths in Science this month as we focus on the topic of air & wind! Through observations, the children will discover that even though we can't see it, air is everywhere & it takes up space. They will learn that all living things need air & that without it, people would have to carry tanks of air around with them like astronauts & scuba divers. They will become familiar with how the plants & trees help us by providing us with the good air (oxygen) that we need. The children will discover that moving air is wind which can be as gentle as our breaths or as strong as a hurricane. We will have a lot of fun experimenting with wind to see how it can make activities easier when it pushes us from behind & how it can make things more difficult when it is facing us.

Mrs. Stevens Reports:

In Creative Movement this month, we will play with the parachute. The children really love it! The parachute encourages the children to work together and utilize their listening skills. Parachute games strengthen the upper torso, building language skills, and developing a sense of rhythm are a few of the benefits of parachute play. Don't forget to ask your child about popping popcorn on the parachute! The children, also will play with the ribbon rainbow while skating to the song Snow Flakes Falling Down! The children also work on their impulse control and listening skills while dancing to the Freeze Dance song.

Ms. Casey Sings:

It's so wonderful to come to Bradley Hills and sing with the children each month. They love to sing along with me and my guitar. We have been busy singing all kinds of fun songs, folk songs, rhyming songs, classics, "Twinkle Twinke" and some dancing songs. The children love to get up and dance to the music and sometimes they will sing along too. We will be starting to practice our show songs next month!





Spanish for the 4's

Mrs. Cardoni Reports:

In Spanish we finished up our lesson on our body (cuerpo). We have learned Spanish words for our body parts and can sing Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes in Spanish (Cabeza, Hombros, Piernas, Pies)! We read <u>De la Cabeza a Los Pies</u> the Eric Carle book (<u>From Head to Toe</u>) translated into Spanish. In February we will be learning about feelings (sentimientos). The children will be singing <u>If You're Happy and You Know It</u> in Spanish but changing the words a bit to sing if you're happy (feliz)- clap (aplauda), if you're mad (enojado)-stomp (pisa), if you're sad (triste)-cry (llora) and if you're silly (tonto)-yell (grita). We will be reading <u>Asi Me Siento Yo</u> (The Way I Feel) by <u>Janan Cain</u>, a lovely rhyming book about feelings and <u>How Do Dinosaurs Say</u> "<u>I'm Mad"</u> by Jane Yolen. We continue to review all of the words we've learned and are amassing quite a vocabulary!
