Cooked Playdough Recipe

- 2 cups white flour
- 1 cup salt
- 2 Tbsp. cream of tartar
- 2 cups of water
- 1 Tbsp. vegetable oil
- food colouring

Combine and cook ingredients over medium heat. Turn out onto counter and knead until smooth. Store in an airtight container.

Please make 2 separate batches to ensure enough for preschool use. Thank you!

Pre-registration for the 2015-16 preschool year will take place by phone on **Saturday**, **January 16 from 9:00 - 11:00 am**. This is open to all families currently enrolled in the preschool, including the siblings of children currently enrolled. If you wish to secure a space for your child for next year, please call Kira at 403-919-8970. Leave a brief message with your name, your child's name, your child's current class (if applicable), the class and time slot you wish to register for, and your email address. You will later receive an email to confirm your message was received. Please note that enrollment is not guaranteed until all registration forms, a copy of your child's birth certificate, and post-dated cheques are received. These are due in the red drop box in the coat room by Friday, January 22nd.

Valentine's Day is fast approaching, and it provides a fun opportunity for students to exchange Valentine's cards with their classmates. If your child would like to participate, please keep in mind the following considerations:

Learning Through Play

Art projects are a staple part of our classroom, and painting holds particular interest for many children. This month, winter colours and shapes help children explore ideas of winter in their paintings. In addition, painting also helps children to:

- develop hand, eye, arm and body coordination
- develop finger and hand muscles

• use shape, form and colour to express themselves in way they do not yet have words for

- experiment with colour and texture
- represent ideas
- show moods and feelings
- begin to develop writing skills
