#### Non-Regular Classes – Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

# CLASSIFICATION, CONT'D

**Brood Bitch Class** – Same as Stud Dog, except replace brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

Brace Class - For two dogs or bitches both with at least one common owner.

**Team Class** – For four dogs or bitches all with at least one common owner.

**Best of Breed** – No defeated dogs will be allowed to compete. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC

**AS A COURTESY TO OUR EXHIBITORS -** No dog owned or co-owned by the Show Chairman will be eligible for entry at this specialty show, nor will they handle any dogs at this specialty show.

# **RV PARKING**

### About the Show Grounds and RV Park:

Canyon RV Park is the hidden jewel of Orange County. Occupying 63 acres of the 795-acre Featherly Wilderness Preserve. It is situated along the Santa Ana River in the heart of the Santa Ana Canyon. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show rules.

THESE SHOWS are governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the Official AKC Entry form in this Premium List.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC E NTRY FORMS and Photocopies of entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. NO ENTRY CAN BE ACCEPTED that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Telegraph or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors after closing date.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS will be **e-mailed** to all entrants who provide email addresses. All others will be mailed by the USPS.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring. There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show.

THE GREAT DANE CLUB OF CA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the South Buckeye Equestrian Center, the Club or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it becomes impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Show Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES: A Recording Fee of 50¢ per dog and an Event Services Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2)

TRANSFER OF ENTRY TO BEST OF BREED: Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the Show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the Show.
