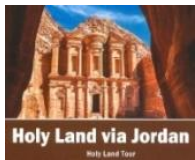

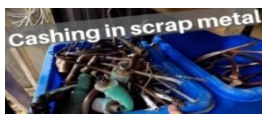

STARTS JULY 19 FROM 6:00-8:30 PM

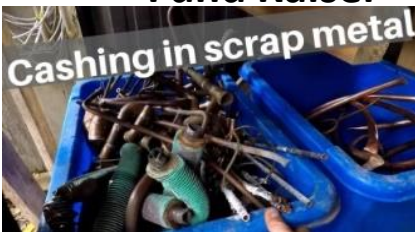
PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED!
