JOIN THE HOABUT WHY?? WHAT DOES THE HOA DO?

Each year the board does its best to encourage neighbors to join the *voluntary* HOA for only \$25 per household. But what's the benefit of joining? One of the many benefits is the reusable discount card we've been providing for 4 years. When used repeatedly, you can save more than the cost of the yearly dues. AND, did you know the HOA board spends lots of time working to maintain the high standards of the Valle Vista subdivision? Through membership dues the HOA can continue working to increase your property

Below is a list of successful projects the board has completed in conjunction with city and local government to improve Valle Vista:

- Worked with city & IURC to convert failing private sanitary sewer system to public & stabilizing rates
- Fought to remove expired sewer surcharge
- Spent 5 7 years working to get streets replaced
- Stopped adjacent subdivisions from connecting to our streets
- Fought to keep comparable home zoning in adjacent developments
- Requested ditches throughout subdivision be cleaned for better water flow & lessen flooding
- Purchased & installed Crime Watch signs with city approval (2 times)
- Requested 2-way signs at Hacienda & Granada
- Upgraded street lights and added 3 new lights for better visibility and improved safety
- Initiated & obtained lane markings on pavement to improve both exits onto Smith Valley Road
- Initiated & obtained repair of street & storm curb inlets where damage was a safety issue
- Met with adjoining HOAs to discuss the impact of possible street widening on Smith Valley Road to 4lanes. Sent feedback letter to city with concerns.

WHAT DOES JOINING MEAN? DO I HAVE TO FOLLOW HOA PROPERTY RULES IF I JOIN?

No. It's as simple as that. As a member, you are not committing to any additional rules. The only rules that apply to EVERYONE (regardless of whether you join or not) are the city ordinances currently in place. For example, if you want to build a deck, put up a fence or mini barn, or add on to your home, ONLY city ordinances apply. Since the city determines the ordinances, any violations need to be brought to their attention. Go to http://www.greenwood.in.gov/ for more information on Greenwood ordinances.

WHAT INCENTIVES ARE THERE FOR JOINING?

- Local community reusable discount card good for one calendar year (January to December)
- FREE attendance to gain personal enrichment in various HOA hosted seminars and classes
- Ability to place in the annual Green Thumb community curb appeal competition
- Chance to be awarded potential giveaways or door prizes at the annual member meeting
- Ability to host block parties

In addition, the board funds the advertising for the spring and fall garage sales, prepares and sends out at least three newsletters each year, holds an annual meeting with guest speakers to educate on area happenings and safety, provides welcome baskets to new residents, maintains a website, and coordinates neighborhood activities like the plant swap. These activities benefit the neighborhood as a whole, and we hope the board's effort to keep them going year after year encourages households to join.
