- 2. The **RECOMMENDED** birth date for Market Lambs is Dec. 1, 2019– March 15, 2020.
- 3. Weight: Market lambs need to weigh a minimum of 90 pounds, with a maximum weight of 140 pounds.
- 4. All classes will be placed 1st through 6th. Premiums will be paid as follows: 1st 16 pts., 2nd 14 pts, 3rd 12 pts, 4th 10 pts, 5th 8 pts, and 6th 6 pts. Rosettes will be awarded for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion (no cash premium).
