Awake invites you to take advantage of this drug and alcohol awareness program. **Hidden In Plain Sight** is an interactive presentation intended for parents, grandparents, caregivers, as well as foster parents and social service agency staff. This presentation is centered around a teenager's bedroom. The presentation includes information on current trends, how to recognize ordinary household items being used in unordinary ways and tips for how to talk to teenagers about alcohol, drugs and other potentially risky behaviors.



Program Overview

- **Help adults identify ordinary household items used in unordinary ways.**
- **Inform adults on current trends including drug types, drug paraphernalia and how drugs are used and why.**
- **Provide tips on how parents and caregivers can talk to their kids about drugs and alcohol.**
- **Provide information on available resources if risky behavior is suspected.**
