

# WELCOME

The Raymond Sutton family extends a warm welcome to you for our 65th annual Quarter Horse production sale. We believe it is the oldest Quarter Horse production sale in the world.

We are a working ranch that raises horses, cattle and bison. Yearly income is from our livestock and we take our breeding programs very seriously. Our family has been raising superior quality horses and cattle for over a century. In 2001, we joined the elite list of the first 48 breeders to receive the AQHA Legacy Award for 50 continuous years of raising Quarter Horses. This year we will register our 2726th foal. During the ninety odd years we have been in the registered livestock business, our programs have had constant breed improvement as their foremost goal. It is our philosophy that a controlled bloodline-breeding program makes dominant breeders with distinctive carry-on breeding ability. Although we have outcrosses, our program has maintained good, solid foundation lines that have that carry-on ability.

When someone mentions a Sutton bred horse, the bloodlines have proven themselves over and over. We are very proud that our select band of mares and stallion battery are among the top in the nation. The World Champion Palomino Youth 14-18 Barrel Horse and the PRCA Barrel Horse of the

Year were both purchased as weanlings in our sale. Solid Gold Edition tied for 5th in year-end standings for AQHA Senior Stallions. The produce of Miss Winning Gal was first in AQHA Produce of Dam. Bill's Rock tied for 1st in AQHA Get-of-Sire standings for 2 years; Barnone Impressive was 3rd. Patty Punk tied for 1st in AQHA Produce of Dam and Peggy Note was 1st. A few years ago, 8 of the AQHA Year End High Point Horses could trace their pedigrees to Sutton bred stock. Our breeding program is not a fluke but something developed over years of careful matings and constant scrutiny.

Our goal is horses with superior dispositions, intelligence, conformation, and ability. We strive to produce horses that excel in looks and can perform in a number of disciplines. This year the ranch has horses qualified for the World Show in Heading, Performance Stallions, Senior Cutting, Amateur Cutting, Junior Working Cowhorse, and Ranch Riding. Our 4-year-old stallion, RWS Vacas Benito Bar, won the Boxing at the Ranching Heritage Challenge in June.

Foals run in hundreds of acres on our river pastures until the sale. They are strong, fit, and agile. The natural conditions allow the foals to develop bone structure, heart and lungs, and the muscular system. Research shows that the broader and more varied the types of exercise the young horse receives, the more overall body strength and soundness the foal develops. The large pastures

give the developing foals physical and mental experiences that develop overall body strength and athletic ability. This can greatly increase the young horse's chances of long term superior performance.

Our stallion battery and mare band carry some of the best foundation and modern breeding to be found. The offspring are equally at home in the showing or rodeo arena, doing ranch work, or as a family friend. They don't have to be bucked out or ridden miles before they become dependable! The number of customers that return year after year to buy our horses is testimony to the success of our breeding program. It is not unusual for a customer to call wanting foals to replace horses gotten from us that are getting a little aged. The horses will be on display for you Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning. This will give you plenty of time to look over anything you might be interested in. Before sale day if you wish to stop by the ranch and look over the offering let us know when you are coming, we are always happy to have you see our herds.

In the many years we have been raising livestock, we have gained a respected reputation for fair dealing and standing behind what we sell. We value the trust people like you have in us and will continue to serve you as best we can.

We look forward to hosting you at our 65th annual sale!

She is just starting her show career but this spring she has been used to drag dead fall out of the shelter belt. Morgan (her owner) says "I am getting her ready for the ranch horse competitions. The rope and dragging logs don't faze her at all." Amber's dam, Peppermints Echo, has palomino pleasure points. Vintage Impressive's family tree is all performance plus conformation. Bay Punk was the first all-around horse in the SDQHA. Coupled with the ability that Cutter San Cody adds, this could be a good candidate for cattle events or a weekend pleasure ride.

We like to do some linebreeding in our program. This is a good example of hard to find genetics...a 3X Babe Cody. Babe Cody is credited in the Legends series, Volume 5, as being one of the most influential early sires in the Northern Plains. He stood at the Sutton Ranches for over 20 years and made his mark on the industry siring 11 AQHA Champions, AQHA Superiors, and ROMs. Comet's grandsire, Billy Nick Cody was shown in open and youth classes. He earned year-end awards in both. The one thing all of us that rode "Cody" bred horses remark is "did they have to be that smart!" We have kept 2 of Comet's fillies to put in the broodmare band.

When you couple these genetics you get Peppy 3X with Bill Cody, Cutter Bill, and Jackie Bee (all three are in the AQHA Hall of Fame). Powerful genetics for a super working candidate plus mom has a really calm disposition.

She is also in the AQHA Hall of Fame. Dry Doc was an NCHA Futurity Champion, is in the NCHA Hall of Fame, is #16 on the top 50 NCHA Leading Sire. On the bottom is AQHA Superior Horse, Duplicate Dude by AQHA Hall of Fame horse, Blondy's Dude. Sassy Sabrina traces back to Mr Blackburn 40, Peter McCue, and Royal King. Add in 2X Colonel Freckles, Smart Little Lena, and Miss N Cash. They don't come any more royally bred.

Amaria's dam (Cutter Bill/Two Eyed Jack) was the high point junior cutting horse in the Center of the Nation Quarter Horse Association (CONQHA) and reserve in the South Dakota Cutting Horse Association (SDQHA). She was high point amateur cutting horse in both associations for two years. As well as working points she had open, amateur, and youth halter points and circuit championships. This filly's half-brother, RWS Vacas Benito Bar, and Heather won the boxing at the Ranching Heritage Challenge in June. "Ben" is qualified for the World in Ranch Riding, has both open and amateur All-Around titles, and was the Reserve Champion 3-year-old stallion at the AQHA Region 2 Championship Show.

Royal Chickabell is the dam of an 2015 Amateur Classic Finalist at the NCHA Superstakes. We have kept 3 of Chickabell's foals.. two for the mare band and one that is now competing in calf roping and heeling. You will look a long time to find a pedigree like this. Hickoryote has LTE \$107,500, but he is a mare sire and his get and grand - get know the inside of cows. His sire, Doc's Hickory is an AQHA son of Doc Bar. He is an AQHA Champion and #4 all time leading cutting sire and #6 all time leading reined cowhorse sire. His dam, Jazabell Quixote is one of only 4 mares in the history of the NCHA to have won more than \$200,000, and produced off-spring with more than a \$1 Million earnings. She is now the #5 NCHA mare for earnings. Chickabell carries this mare's genetics top and bottom. On the bottom, Dual Jazz, stood at Joe Landers in Texas before moving to Australia. He has LTE \$60,370 NCHA. Dual Pep has "get" earnings in excess of \$24 Million. This youngster is 2X Doc Bar and 3X Cutter Bill. Good genetics!







"Peppy's" bottom is strong working blood. Solito Badger makes him 2x Mr San Peppy. Solita Doc makes him 2x Doc Bar plus Honey Peco is Hank Bar by Sugar Bars so he is 3x Three Bars. Add foundation blood of Pretty Buck and 3x Poco Bueno. All this adds up to a lot of relation that have proven records in cattle events, on the race track, and in the show ring.

This stallion provides an excellent nick with our other bloodlines.

# CUTTER SAN CODY

Blood doesn't get much bluer than this. "Cody" carries the genetics of Mr San Peppy, Doc Holliday, Cutter Bill, and Bill Cody, all horses that are proven sires with gets that are recognized for their outstanding athletic ability and brains.

Silk Delight has a number of brothers that we showed. Rocky Bill Cody was an AQHA and an AQHA Champion. He carried Heather to the High Point Youth Senior Girl, All-Around Youth, Youth Gelding, 14-18 Western Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, Showmanship, Horsemanship, and Equitation year-end awards in the South Dakota Quarter Horse Association (SDQHA). He earned his open championship with points

in halter, western pleasure, heading and heeling as well as gaining the Reserve All-Around title for the SDQHA. Another brother, Classic Macho Man, was SDQHA high point yearling stallion and he and Rocky" were 2/3 of the group that garnered the AQHA's Year End Award for Get-of-Sire for Bill's Rock. A third brother, Bill Rock Cody, was reserve yearling stallion. Silk Delight herself was reserve Amateur mare in both the SDQHA and the Center of the Nation Quarter Horse Association (CONQHA). She also was in the top half of the horses the year she competed in the Dakota Classic Cutting Futurity.

Caca Cody is a full sister to the outstanding halter mare, Dream Babe. Their sire, Babe

Cody (6x Old Sorrel) is credited in Legends Volume 5 as being one of the most influential early sires in the Northern Plains. He sired 11 AQHA Champions, 9 Superior Halter and Performance horses, and 20 ROMs. A number of his foals had points in cutting and reining. Bill Cody was AQHA 's first Honor Roll Halter Horse. He was the sire of Joe Cody "the patriarch of the Quarter Horse breed's first great reining horse dynasty". That was after his great success in the cutting pen.

We donated one of his daughters to the Ranching Heritage Young Horse Development Program, RWS A Peppy Delight. Check out her 2-year-old photo with owner, Morgan aboard!

# JUST A SILVER DUCK

Just A Silver Duck is a very refined, halter pretty silver grulla stallion with all the correct moves in the cutting pen. He was runner-up to our Rios Santana in the South Dakota Cutting Horse Association for \$1,000 Horse. He and Heather lead the \$15,000 amateur completion. He is nearing his NCHA COA.

Just A Silver Duck is a son of Blue Duck Okie (Miss N Cash, Smart Little Lena, Colonel Freckles, , Doc Bar, Mr San Peppy) out of Just A Grulla Streak (Colonel Freckles, Peponita, Ed Echols, Doc Bar).

On his topside is Blue Duck Okie LTE 148,871. His accomplishments: NCHA Derby, Top Ten World Show, NCHA money-earner, World Show Qualifier, and ROM Performance. In the first three years of competition he get earned \$88,000. His sire, Miss N Okie, is a son of Miss N Cash (Dash For Cash son). "Okie" has LTE of \$5,756 but his offspring have proven his ability with earnings of \$496,000. His dam, Smart Fancy Lena, is a daughter of Smart Little Lena. "Fancy" has LTE of \$48,453 and her produce earnings of \$418,383. Blue Duck Okie has been sold to a South American

buyer and will stand south of the equator.

On his bottomside is Just A Freckle (Superior Performance, NCHA money-earner, ROM Performance} a son of AQHA Hall of Fame Colonel Freckles whose grandget have earned over \$14 million in NCHA and NRHA competition. Lucky Senbar (Top Ten World Show, '81 7th Senior Cutting, NCHA money-earner, ROM Performance). His get have 353 AQHA Performance Points, Performance ROMs, Superior Performance Awards and NCHA LTE: \$145,179.

# LEGENDARY CUTTER

His genetics say that he should sire individuals with cowsense and speed. His sire, Legendary Rock, placed in a number of cutting futurities and had AQHA Grand Championships. On the top is Cutter Bill and Two Eyed Jack for working ability. For speed he has Rapid Bar AAA + and Mr Barnone AAA + .

On the bottom is AQHA Superior Horse and AQHA Champion credits from Solid Gold Edition. His dam's mother is a full sister to Sparky Impression, PRCA Barrel Horse of the Year and earner of \$250,000 + . He is 4X Three Bars.

We have not been able to show "Cutter's"

ability due to a neck injury as a foal. His daughter, RWS Legendary Gal, we donated to the Ranching Heritage Young Horse Development Program. She and her owner, Brandy, hit the showing in Pennsylvania. Refer to the photos to see her first win.

# PEPPY PEDRO BADGER

Peppy Pedro Badger has the genetics to do anything you desire be it in the show pen, rodeo, or trail riding. Last year his daughter, RWS Cocoa D Or Badger, was high point Yearling Mare and Reserve Amateur Yearling mare in the SDQHA. Another daughter, RWS Peppys Sandy Doc saw action in the cutting pens of SD and NE and was 3rd in boxing at the Ranching Heritage Challenge.

His sire, Solito Badger, was raised on the King Ranch. He sired the Champion Junior Reining Horse in Idaho, the Canadian Reserve Champion Appaloosa Working Cow Horse, the High Point Reining Horse in North Dakota, and out of 600 entries in the 2001 National Reining Horse Futurity he sired two

of the semi-finalists. Solito Badger's sire is the great Peppy San Badger (Little Peppy): NCHA Futurity Champion, NCHA Derby Champion, NCHA Reserve World Champion, NCHA Hall of Fame, #2 on the Top 50 NCHA Leading Sires list. His get have won over \$20 million in the NCHA. He is ranked #4 on the leading paternal grandsire list and #8 on the maternal grandsire list. Solito's dam has two full sisters who have a produce that has done well in the NCHA. His full brother stood at stud for the government of Argentina.

"Pedro's" dam is a granddaughter of AQHA Hall of Fame Horse, Blondy's Dude and is a half sister to Carol Rose's famous Diamond's Sparkle. (for more information on Blondy's

Dude refer to Te Boston Dude's notes). Her sire, Duplicate Dude, is a Superior Trail Horse and placed 4th at the AQHA World Show. Her dam, is by Forty Pecos who had Grand and Reserve halter wins. He is by Mr Blackburn 40, a son of Pretty Buck, who was an AQHA Champion and won the Denver Stock Show twice. His dam on top is by Poco Pine out of a mare raised on the Waggoner Ranch. On the bottom is Mr Blackburn 11 who is by a Poco Bueno out of another Waggoner Ranch mare.

If you want foundation breeding with a modern, sharp profile then the foals by this stallion bear looking over.

# RIOS SANTANAS

Rio has had a good showing in the cutting pen. He and Heather won the \$1,000 rider in the South Dakota Cutting Horse Association and were second in the \$1500 amateur for NCHA Area 6. He was champion \$1,000 horse in NE and SD. He is a few dollars from his NCHA COA.

There is no one in the working horse world today who has not heard of his grandsire, Peptoboonsmal – winner of \$180,000 and sire of a get that earned over \$ 3.7 million in the first 4 foal crops that showed. He is ranked 4th leading cutting sire, 6th leading paternal grandsire, and 5th leading maternal grandsire. His get are athletic and smart. Rio's granddam, Miss Santana Doc, is a full

sister in blood to Smart Little Lena and dam of Dry N Freckled, the 51st highest money earning cutting horse ever at \$268,000.

Ms Rio Rock is a full sister to Tara Rock, the mare that Georgia showed to the high point junior and amateur cutting titles for two years in the South Dakota Quarter Horse Association and the Center of the Nation Quarter Horse Association. Both of these mares had the typical Bill's Rock love of people and his kind dispositions. They passed this on to their produce. Their granddam, Sonora Gal, was the mother of Sonora Babe, a multiple champion cutting mare by Babe Cody. Their grandsires, AQHA Hall of Fame Horse, Two Eyed Jack and NCHA Hall of Fame Horse,

Cutter Bill needs no introduction.

Rio's get are eye catchers with sharp profiles and chrome paired with their sire's great disposition (his foals halter break very easily). His 2-year-old son, RWS A Legendary Rio, that we donated to the Ranching Heritage Young Horse Development Program has done well. He was Champion AQHA California Exhibitors Youth Yearling Gelding and was third in the Young Horse Development Project last year. Check out his photo with his owner, Malabie aboard!

# THE PAINTED RAVEN

This may be the last offering of "Raven" foals. We searched a long time for a paint stallion with the quality and pedigree to fit into our program. "Raven's" get has quiet dispositions, are quick learners, and do work cattle with ease. They are very easy to handle when we halter break the foals. If all youngsters were like these, life would be simple. A son has brought home a number of first places in Pinto shows.

In this pedigree there is a touch of Quarter Horse, but there is Paint parentage for three generations and all are overo. His sorrel overo son, RWS Sizzlin Robin, won the open Paint weanling title at the SDPHA futurity, was first in the yearling halter stallions and yearling trail in the Southeast South Dakota Horse Shows Association. He went on to be suc-

cessfully shown by his 70 year young owner. A two-year-old son carried his owner, Miss North Dakota, trail riding in the Black Hills this summer. He then came home to work cattle on her fiancé's ranch.

"Raven" had limited showing and earned points in both open and amateur halter. He was circuit champion 3-year-old at the SDPHA Paint-Orama and SDPHA reserve 3-year-old stallion. He goes back to Painted Robin 4x, Robin Reed 5x, and boasts some War Leo, Buck Hancock, Old Tom Cat, Win or Lose, Sonny Dee Bar, and Nero in his pedigree.

He came from Jack Campbell's breeding program and has well known relation in his background. Cash Bond is an APHA Champion with 485 halter points, ROMs in

3 events, and a Superior in 2 events. Painted Robin is an APHA leading sire of halter and performance winners. Gingersnap has 15 halter points and is ROM. Red Sonny Robin has 105 halter points, 10 performance points, 2 ROMs, and 1 Superior. Speck Away Too was ROM in pleasure with a computer index of 94.5 at 350 yards and a performance rating of 96.5. He is the sire of Mr Robin Boy, APHA Superior All Around Champion and National Champion Aged Halter Stallion. Raven Robin's get win their share of awards with 38 halter, 2 performance, 1 APHA Championship, and 2 ROMs. Miss Red Sonny's produce has 5 halter points.

# SWEET GALLO OAK

Sweet Gallo Oak was destined to be a top reining horse but he injured a leg in training. The “feed-back” was that he was one of the most talented two-year-olds Todd Summers had worked with. His turns were cat quick and he was really beginning to sit down.

His sire, Gallo Del Cielo, was a finalist in the NCHA Open Derby and a number of

prestigious cutting events but his real place in history comes from his distinction as being the ninth standout stallion to earn the NRHA Million Dollar Sire status. “Oak’s” dam is a ¾ sister to Doc’s Stylish Oak, winner of over \$77,000 in cutting and ranking on the Leading Cutting Sire list. His performers have averaged \$19,600 in earnings. The foals in this offering add potent genetics that can only

make them successful in whatever event you choose. Heather showed Sweet Tequila Oak in reining and ranch pleasure. We donated his daughter, RWS Oaks Slipper, to the Ranching Heritage Young Horse Development Project. She is just beginning her career in the show-rings of Indiana.

# YOUNG POBRE

Young Pobre was raised on the King Ranch. You would have to look long and hard to find better breeding. Peppy San Badger is #2, Freckles Playboy is #3, and Doc O’Lena is #5 leading NCHA Sires of Money Earners. Peppy San Badger is #4, Doc O’Lena is #7, and Freckles Playboy #8 in Leading Paternal Grandsires: Freckles Playboy is #3, Peppy San Badger #8, and Doc O’Lena #19 in Leading Maternal Grandsires. Here are genetics that have proven themselves through the generations.

Young Gun has a get that has earned over \$2,300,000. He is an Equi-Stat All-Time Leading Cutting Sire, an AQHA Top 15 Leading

Sire of Point-Earners, and an NRCHA All-Time Leading Sire. He is a full brother to earners of over \$517,000. His dam, Leanette, is an Equi-Stat All-Time Leading Producer. Her foals and grandfoals have earned over \$2,500,000.

Pobre’s great granddam was the mare Anita Chica, unbeaten in her show career and earner of 199 halter points. She is buried at the King Ranch alongside Old Sorrel, Wimpy, and Mr San Peppy. El Pobre and Leo are as foundation as you can get.

Young Pobre has not been in the show pen but to watch him in the pasture at play, you know that he has all the right moves. He can flat get down and skim the dirt. His get are

athletes with minds. Steve Burke of North Dakota has one that he says nothing bothers whether it is trail riding at Medora or chasing escaped horses down the highway ditch in the middle of the night.

RWS Pobres Allusive and RWS Annie Get Your Gun are Pobre daughter in Texas that bring home lots of calf roping honors. “Allusive” was the Texas Junior High School Rodeo Calf Roping Champion, the Texas Junior Rodeo Association All-Around Horse and Champion at the Joe Beaver Invitational Roping. ## TERMS OF SALE

Terms of the sale are cash in United States currency payable immediately after the sale unless other arrangements have been made prior to the sale. Checks will be considered cash. If you are unable to attend the sale, you may mail your bids or telephone your bids sale day. Any buyer wishing to transact business in this manner is requested to provide a letter of credit at least three days prior to the sale. The sale day telephone number is 605-264-5452.

After being sold, the sellers will handle the horses to the best of their ability, but assume no further liability for their safekeeping. Any expenses incurred after the gavel falls shall be the sole responsibility of the buyer. Buyers who will not be removing horses within 24 hours must make arrangements for their care until they can be removed. Horses not removed in a timely manner will be charged \$3 per day care. A charge of 1-1/2% per month will be charged on any outstanding amounts due. The entire amount is due within 6 month after the sale date or the horse will be repossessed.

Any person attending this sale does so at their own risk. Neither the Suttons or any other person connected with this sale assumes any liability, legal or otherwise.

## WARRANTIES

All known defects will be printed in the catalog or called when the horse enters the ring and announced before sold. Any problem with a horse must be reported to the seller within one week of the sale. Announcements from the auction block will take precedence over the catalog. There is no breeding soundness guarantee on foals sold. Any veterinarian expenses incurred after the horse is sold are the sole responsibility of the buyer.

## BREEDERS INFORMATION

The buyer will be furnished with all necessary papers to transfer purchases. The buyer will pay the APHA or

AQHA transfer fee and this will be added to the purchase price. The AQHA and APHA have adopted a member/nonmember fee schedule for registration and transfers. Membership information for both associations will be available sale day and all buyers will be charged the member price.

Registration papers will be held until checks clear the bank. When the check has cleared, the registration papers along with transfer and the fees will be sent to the AQHA/APHA and transferred to the name of the buyer. Buyers should be prepared to give the exact name and membership number to the sale clerk that they want on the registration certificate when they settle up for their purchases.

- All foals are well halter broken.
- All foals were dewormed in August.
- All horses have their Coggins Test and are ready for shipment to the 50 states and Canada.
- A veterinarian will be on the grounds sale day for necessary interstate certificates, etc.
- For international shipment, arrangements can be made for a federal veterinary inspection.
- If you live more than 500 miles from us, delivery to a central point may be a possibility - check with us before sale day.
- If you are planning to haul just one weanling we suggest that you bring an older horse as a babysitter on the way home!


