Dear Friends,

I watched in amazement as officer after officer arrived at the restaurant. Patrol officers, detectives, the SWAT team and others filled the room. All 48 of us barely fit in the back room of this restaurant where we hold our monthly evangelistic outreach. They were all on duty and we had an hour to feed them and present the gospel to them. They were all part of the Adams Country Sheriff's Office here in Colorado.

Chaplain Brian Thompson presented the gospel and I rejoiced as most of these officers who are not believers heard the gospel. There is no greater joy for me than to be part of an evangelistic ministry. The commander sitting across from me had come to one of our other lunch outreaches and after hearing the gospel sought out Chaplain Thompson who led him to Christ. The harvest continues to be ready in this country and around the world.

The law enforcement officers in this country continue to be under attack. Just last month two sheriff's deputies in Florida were killed as they were eating in a restaurant. These were young officers in their 20s who were killed by someone who hated law enforcement. I have been amazed at the amount of hatred toward law enforcement in our country in the past 10 years. God has called us to minister to these officers who are serving God.

God has blessed us with 14 staff members who are helping us to reach law enforcement officers here in this country. We have 4 lunches a month in different cities here in Colorado for law enforcement. Since the work of law enforcement officers is dangerous and none of them know when they will be attacked by those who hate them; it is urgent that they hear the gospel and know that their sins can be forgiven, and they can become children of God.

Marlene and I will be in New Jersey the beginning of May and will be sharing at 3 of our supporting churches. We will also be having an evangelistic outreach to law enforcement in Carney's Point, NJ. Please be in prayer for this event as we invite officers from that part of the state to join us.

We are also planning trips to Honduras, Costa Rica, El Salvador and Sierra Leone, Africa, this year. Pray that God will provide the finances and team members for these trips. Also continue to pray for a harvest among the law enforcement officers we are proclaiming the gospel to here in the USA. Thank you for your prayers and financial support as we proclaim the gospel and make disciples as Jesus commanded us to do. May God continue to bless you in every way.
