FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Fire Department reported monthly runs so far have been 15 fire and 38 EMS for a total of 446 runs YTD. Mutual aid was provided to Amanda, Berne, Clearcreek, Bremen-Rushcreek, and Lancaster. A total of 2 runs to SCI. Covid-19 is still an ongoing issue.

OLD BUSINESS

1. The county will keep Hocking Township informed as to the progress of the OPWC on Meister Road.
2. Hocking Township will continue to monitor Stonewall Cemetery Road and Stepath Mound Lane for erosion.
3. Health Department meeting was the first of March. There is a committee formed to work on some budget issues with them and to plan for the future.
4. Trustee Shaw motioned to move forward with the budgeted amount of \$150,000 for paving with McKee. Trustee Wolfe seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe – Yes. Motion approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Spoke with McKee, Spires, and Shelly concerning the back of Stepath Mound Lane and the end of Stonewall Cemetery. Will be getting a quote to have a couple of those areas paved with a smaller paver.
2. Trustee Ellinger spoke about the proposed fire levy to be placed on the 2020 ballot. Trustee Wolfe motioned to proceed with the fire levy for 1.8 mills for a continuing period. Trustee Shaw seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe - Yes. Motion approved.
3. Trustee Wolfe motioned to accept the Ag Pro bid for a new tractor and attachments to be funded out of FY21 funds. Trustee Shaw seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe - Yes. Motion approved.

There being no further business to discuss Trustee Ellinger motioned to adjourn and Trustee Wolfe seconded the motion.




