NOTE:

- This is a "pet-friendly" dog show.
- The Dog Show will be held at grandstand area unless the weather forces it to be moved to the livestock show barn. A registration table will be located at the grandstands. Dog owners are encouraged to enter from the Grandstands ticket booth entry gate.
- Dog show exhibitors are not allowed to park on the grounds. Must use designated parking areas.
- Dogs are entered at the sole risk of the exhibitor or owner of the animal.

— RULES —

- Registration begins at 7:30 a.m.
- Entries will be accepted until class starts.
- Entry fee for classes 1-9 shall be \$1.00 each. No entry fee for classes 10-14 but owner must register for these classes.
- Entries eligible for Best Old Dog are for dogs 8 years or older.
- Entries eligible for class 10 are first place ribbon winners from all previous classes exhibited by a child.
- Any adopted dog can be registered for the Best Adopted Dog award.
- Committee reserves the right to combine two or more classes under a miscellaneous class when there is only one entry in a class.
- For the dog's safety, no puppies under eight weeks old shall be allowed in the show.
- All dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- Owners must control dogs and keep away from livestock. Tying dogs on livestock wash area fencing is prohibited.
- No dogs are allowed on the fairgrounds except during the dog show. Dogs are not allowed in any building or on the midway. Handler is responsible for feces clean-up.
- Ribbons will be awarded for first five places. Blue-1; Red-2; White-3; Yellow-4; Green-5. Prize money will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places.

PRIZES: 1st - \$4; 2nd - \$3; 3rd - \$2; 4th - \$1
