

Nominating Resolutions:

Constitution and Bylaws Resolutions:

Art 3, Sect 301 (Eligibility for Membership)

Resolved Summary: Eligibility for membership in the FRA shall be open to all personnel who have served or are now serving in an enlisted or in an officer status in the Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard, qualified Merchant Marine, Naval Academy Midshipmen, Coast Guard Academy Cadets, Merchant Marine Midshipmen regardless of length in service, including reserve components.

Art 7, Sect 701(d) (Pertains to numbers years the National President and Vice-President may be elected for a one-year term.)

Resolved Summary: The Annual Convention on alternating years shall elect for a two-year term the National Vice-President and President, and for a three-year term,

the National Executive Director in a year the number is divisible by three. Art 7, Sect 701(g) (Pertains to numbers years the Regional President and

Vice-President may be elected for a one-year term.) Resolved Summary:

Regional Presidents and Vice-Presidents shall be elected for a two-year term. In the event a region fails to hold a convention for such elections, and the National Convention has been canceled, vacancies of the offices which are due to expire shall be filled by the National Board of Directors as provided in Section 705(a).

<u>Art 8, Sect 813 (National Committee on Membership and Retention)</u> Resolved Summary:

Section 813(a). The committee shall consist of a chairman and eight

members, one from each region. Section 813(b). The primary duty of this committee, in conjunction with the Director of Membership Development is to devise ways and means of increasing FRA membership, improving membership retention and publi-cizing the aims and purposes of the FRA among eligible potential members.

Section 813(c). Duties of the Director of Membership Development: Adding Section 813(c) (1-5)....

Art 8, Sect 813 (National Committee on Membership and Retention) **Resolved Summary:**

Section 813(a). The committee shall consist of a Chairman and the Regional Vice President from each region. The Director of Membership Development shall act as an advisor.

Section 813(b). The primary duty of this committee is to devise ways and means of increasing FRA membership, improving membership retention and publicizing the aims and purposes of the FRA among eligible

potential members. Section 813(c). The chairman shall make an annual report to the delegates at the National Convention reporting the status of Association member ship, programs and retention; a membership and retention program for the next Association year and any pertinent recommendations.

Standing Rule-1: (Adds a Standing Rule(s) for the FRA Veterans Service Foundation) Resolved Summary:

The FRA Veterans Service Foundation. Adds SR-___(a) thru (e).

<u>Standing Rule-2: (Amends SR-5(b) National Awards)</u> Resolved Summary:

(1) For the purpose of competing for awards addressed in this standing rule, branches shall be assigned to competitive groups as follow: Group I - 500 members or more Group IV - 50 to 99 members. Group II - 300 to 499 members. Group V - 10 to 49 members.

Group III - 100 to 299 members.
