

Beginners Rail Fence Quilt

Instructor: Patsy Mosby

Supplies:

Book: Alex Anderson's Start Quilting, 3rd Edition (please read pp.4-14 before class)

Rotary cutter...*recommended: 45mm with retractable blade

Rotary ruler...*recommended: 6"X12"

Rotary mat...*recommended: medium size, approx. 17"X23"

*Suggestions only; if you have comparable sizes, bring them.

Fine, piecing or patchwork pins

Basic sewing supplies, pincushion, scissors (small-medium), seam ripper,

Thread: 100% cotton, 50 wt. for machine, neutral color *Masterpiece or Aurofil

SEWING MACHINE: Make sure it is in good working order and you are familiar with operating it. Bring power cord, foot control, and instruction book.

Fabrics: 100% cotton, no stripes or plaids, please!

Focus Fabric (outside border) $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. *Choose a colorful print you love!

Rail Fence blocks.. $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. each, of **three** fabrics (not nine, as book says)

Inner border and binding... $\frac{5}{8}$ yd.

Backing: $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yd.

Additional supplies for Sessions 2, 3, and 4 are listed below. You do not need them for the first class.

Walking foot or even-feed foot for your machine (required for quilting)

Cotton or 80/20 batting (43"X43") Binding clips

Thread to match binding Marking tool, or hera marker

1" basting safety pins Masking tape

Hand sewing needle

PLEASE DO NOT CHOOSE BORDERS THAT NEED TO BE FUSSY CUT, OR CHANGE THE SIZE OF THIS QUILT!!! After you have completed this class, you'll be able to be creative with size, etc.
