

MAKE SURE YOU VOTE IN THE NOVEMBER 3 GENERAL ELECTION

Early ballots will be mailed starting October 7, 2020.
They need to be mailed back no later than October 28, 2020 and received by the County Recorder before 7:00 PM on Election Day, November 3, 2020.

If you will be out-of-town in October, you can have your early ballot mailed to your temporary address.

The Post Office WILL NOT forward your ballot. You must ask the County Recorder to do this.
Please submit your request ASAP.
