Falling Steel PA Falling Steel Match October 13th. The match will consist of 7 stages, 25-35 targets per stage. 175-200 total.

- · All knockdown steel will be used.
- Squads will be limited to 12 shooters per squad (72 shooters per time slot). If the time slot you requested is filled, you will be notified and given the option to select another one, if available.
- Shooters may shoot in four divisions; however, you must shoot in two different time slots.
- You may shoot as "Single" meaning you shoot by yourself, or as "Team" meaning you and another shooter will be shooting each stage simultaneously. In theory, each teammate only has half the targets, and each team only pays one entry fee.
