Step #4 - Plan Ahead

ELECTION OF NOMINATING COMMITTEE for the 2021-2023 term will take place. All districts are entitled to be represented in the important work that helps identify our future leaders. This is a significant position for the future of our organization. Seven districts are represented on each nominating committee. Those districts that were represented this term are ineligible for the term of 2021-2023. So, all but the districts mentioned below are eligible to provide a member of the next committee. PRIOR to Convention, please identify a candidate from your district (and a potential back-up) who is willing and able to do this work and who will attend all state meetings next term (it is necessary to have a quorum at each meeting to conduct business). It could be you! Be prepared for the election of the nominating committee.

Districts ineligible for the 2021-2023 term: Buttes, Channel Islands, Golden Foothills, Humboldt, San Fernando Valley, Valley Lode and Yosemite Gateway.
