FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. **2. Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation;**

10) USEA beginner Novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. EC 7/21/08 Effective 12/1/08

3. Hunter fences to include brush, gate, wall, in and out, aiken, natural rails. Jumper fences to include brush, coop, wall, planks, panels, liverpools and rails.
4. Indian Hills Farm and Horse Show Management shall not be liable whatsoever for any injury or damage to any person or property of any spectator, visitor, attendant or any other persons, or animals by reason of any event occurring during the show, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold the same as well as their agents and/or employees harmless for any accident or loss which may occur by fire or otherwise.
5. The right is reserved to cancel, combine or divide any classes if entries warrant. In addition, the right is reserved to refuse any entry before the start of the competition without being liable for compensation.
6. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by a **MANDATORY LINE**. The same will be indicated on course diagrams and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.
7. Riders to be properly attired for all classes. Protective headgear is required at all times when mounted.
8. Measurements available by appointment with New England Equine Practice.
9. Absolutely **NO DOGS** or other pets allowed on the grounds unless leashed and under control.
10. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.
11. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have **CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS** for any and all classes, which require the same.
- 12. POST ENTRIES** accepted if time permits.
13. Footing Outdoor ring, 100x225. Indoor 80x200, South Outdoor Ring 180x200
14. Stabling: 10x10 permanent stalls with doors.

15. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s) or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent, guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of the rule will be cause for sanctions against the parents, guardians, and/or trainers who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent, guardian, and/or trainer from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Member Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ATTENTION COMPETITORS



USEF SAFE SPORT TRAINING REQUIREMENT

Starting January 1, 2019, if you are a USEF Competing Member 18 years of age or older you are required to complete the core Safe Sport Training within 30 days of activating your membership.

If you do not complete the training, you are ineligible to participate in all USEF activities including competitions.

From Route 80 E:

Take exit 70A towards Leonia. Merge onto Fort Lee Road. Make a right at the first traffic light into the Overpeck Park.

From George Washington Bridge:

Take exit 72B on the left to merge onto U.S. 1 S/US- 46 W/U.S. 9 S toward NJ-4. Take the Main St. exit toward Fort Lee/Leonia. Turn right onto Main St. Continue down the hill on Fort Lee Rd. Make a left at the traffic light after the train tracks into the Overpeck Park.

From the Overpeck Park Entrance:

Follow the signs towards the Bergen Equestrian Center and take the 2nd right in the roundabout. Follow the road until you approach the white fence then bear to the right. Take the 1st left into our parking lot. Follow the sidewalk leading to the double glass doors to the main office to check in.
