Studio Policies

- Hair for females must be in a classical bun for ballet and pulled back in appropriate style for modern, jazz, & tap classes.
- Warm-up suits are not permitted during class.
- Students are expected to be on time for class, and early dismissal must be approved prior to the start of class.
- Eating is not permitted in studios or dressing rooms.
- A smoke-free environment is maintained.
- Ballet Tennessee is not responsible for personal property.
- Students are urged to make up any missed classes. This must be done within the semester and with instructor's approval.
- Ballet Tennessee reserves the right to limit any student's participation for not adhering to correct class attire, or for behavior deemed inappropriate.
- Cover-ups should be worn over class attire, in public.

Registration & Payment

Items Required at Registration

Registration/Payment Information

- A non-refundable \$15 registration per semester fee for individuals or \$20 per semester for families is charged to students. No registration fee is charged to currently enrolled students for June classes.
- When two or more immediate family members are enrolled, a 10% discount will apply to tuition only. Families consist of 2 or more immediate family members.
- A \$10 late fee is charged to late tuition.
- Returned checks are assessed a \$25 charge and the entire tuition must be paid in cash or money order.
- Payment Plans are offered but must be scheduled during enrollment at VBC.
- A \$5 fee is charged to each payment made on a payment plan.
- Cash, Check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, & American Express are accepted.
- Credit Card Payments for classes are charged a credit card fee of \$1.00 per \$100 transaction.

Registration—Since training is continuous from August through May, <u>students will automatically be billed for the 2nd semester that begins in January</u>.

- Pre-registration is advised each term to assure a place in class.
- Class minimums are set at eight (8) students. If the minimum is not met the class will be combined with another class or cancelled.
- New student enrollment after the semester begins are accepted on space available and after a placement class has determined the level.

Refund Policy

- Withdrawals by clients between the first and second class meetings are subject to a \$25 cancellation fee.
- Classes cancelled by a client after the second class meeting are non-refundable.
- Refunds are not issued for missed classes.
- Students are urged to make up any missed classes. This must be done within the semester and with instructor's approval.
