Students: Below is a list of 12 questions. Please select three questions, and on a separate sheet of paper, write or type your answers.

Each answer must be a minimum of 100 words, and no more than 300 words. Please attach your answers and submit with Page 1 of the application. Thank you.

- 1. What factors have played a part in selecting the college/university/trade or vocation school you will be attending?
- 2. Describe your best classroom experience while attending FHS...the one that had the most impact on you. Was it the students? The class content? Your fellow students? Explain.
- 3. What was the greatest challenge you faced in high school not related to academics and how did you work through it?
- 4. In your opinion, what is the most significant social/cultural issue high school teenagers are dealing with today?
- 5. If you could create, abolish or change one rule at FHS, what would it be and why?
- 6. How do you think a high school alumni association can best serve its members?
- 7. One-third of college students fail out before the end of their freshman year. List some of the qualities and skills you believe are critical to be successful in college.
- 8. Describe someone in your life who is very different from you, and something you have learned from that person.
- 9. Who has had the most influence on your life and how?
- 10. What advice would you give junior high students about how to be successful in high school?
- 11. Tell us about ONE thing that makes you really happy.
- 12. Where do you see yourself 10 years from now?
