Tip overlay tips on both sides of the limb—great condition. NO drilled holes. There were a couple of stress lines that were repaired (the repaired lines are a slightly darker shade of brown on the limb). No crazing. A few minor scratches and scuffs. This is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
