## COVID-19 POLICY AND GUIDELINES

With the ongoing COVID-19 restrictions this show is closed to the general public. Entries for this show will close on **Friday November 20th at 9:00 PM**. ALL PERSONS who wish to enter the show grounds will be subjected to a temperature screening upon entering the gates of Journey's End Farm. Those who register higher than 99.5 will not be permitted access.

ALL PERSONS must complete or supply a completed and signed Liability Wavier & COVID-19 Waiver; there will be no exceptions!

Following the current Pennsylvania state guidelines and recommendations, ALL PERSONS must wear a face mask at all times unless they are mounted and observe a minimum of 6ft in social distancing. Horse show management does reserve the right to ask anyone who does not follow these guidelines to leave the property.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Entry fees: \$25.00 per class. Entries close Friday, November 20. Check are to be made out to the CLASSIC SERIES
2. Office and COVID-19 Fee: \$20
3. Marshall/Sterling Classes: \$35 per class.
4. There is controlled schooling from 7:00-7:45 am, for the first two divisions only. Controlled schooling for other divisions, time permitted. Blue / Red rounds run throughout the day.
5. Exhibitors must scratch and/or add classes at the Secretary's stand. Horses exhibited in classes that they are not entered in will be charged a \$25.00 office fee. For classes entered but not exhibited in, you will still be charged for the class.
6. The Horse Show Committee or Journey's End Farm will not be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horse or pony, or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
7. Classes for juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to Dec. 1, 2020
8. Six ribbons awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons in each division.
9. 12 ribbons and prize money awarded for Derbies on Sunday. Winner receives Coolerette and certificate from Essex Classics.
10. Hard hats must be worn while mounted. No exceptions. All hard hats must be ASTM approved.
11. The decision of the Judge and/or Steward will be final.
12. No martingales in under saddle classes.
13. Fence heights are approximate.
14. Management reserves the right to split or combine divisions as necessary
15. **All competing professionals are eligible to receive free entry for one (1) division and one (1) Blue/Red class. To meet criteria, the professional must bring a minimum of two (2) competing clients to the show. The free entry must be used by the professional for a horse or pony that they own.**

# COVID19 POLICY AND GUIDELINES

With the current landscape of the pandemic and the ever changing guidelines from the CDC, Federal, and State Governments, we at the Silver Stirrup and Classic Show Series have enacted the following policy and guidelines to provide everyone with a safe and fun horse show experience.

## • PLEASE FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THE ENTIRE DOCUMENT •

You will NOT be granted access to Journey's End Farm during a Silver Stirrup and Classic Show Series Horse Show presented by Fabulist, LLC if you or anyone in your household have:

1. Tested positive, presumed positive, or has a test pending for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
  2. Been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
  3. Presented a fever of 99.5 F or higher, cough and/or shortness of breath within the last 72 hours.
  4. Been advised by a healthcare professional to self-quarantine within the last 14 days
- Upon entering Journey's End Farm, ALL PERSONS must submit themselves to a temperature check using a hands-free thermometer and signed a Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement.
  - During your time on the show grounds masks are REQUIRED and must be worn unless participants are in the show ring or trainers that are standing at the ingate. \*All riders who choose to wear a face covering while competing will not be penalized.
  - Please use your best judgement in keeping social distancing at a minimum of 6ft from one another. There will be signs posted around the rings to remind everyone to stay socially distant and to wear a mask.
  - There will be no crowding, standing, or congregating at/or around the in gates and staff.
  - If you are not showing in the current division, we ask that you please stand off to the side and refrain from being in large groups.
  - Currently all Silver Stirrup and Classic Horse Shows hosted by Fabulist, LLC are not open to the public or any spectators and are limited to Competitors, Trainers and Immediate Family.
  - Fabulist Management will make every effort to stay up to date on CDC, Federal and State guidelines and use all platforms available to post updated information.
  - Entries for Silver Stirrup and Classic Horse Shows hosted by Fabulist, LLC will close the day prior to the show. Post entries and show day entries will be accepted. The Show office will be where trainers will leave a check for the show to hold before picking up their barns back numbers.
  - Once competitors are finished showing they are to close out in the show office with cash or check. With doing our best to limit contact in the show office, trainers who may have changes are encouraged to contact Katie Benson in the show office or in-gate via text message or call 908-534-8833.
  - We ask that all persons remain mindful and respectful of themselves and their peers as we all do our part during these times. If you feel uncomfortable or have any reservations whatsoever, please stay home.

As Per Pennsylvania Equine Activity Immunity Act Law, I assume the risk of all equine activities pursuant to Pennsylvania Law. I also agree to allow Silver Stirrup Show Series and Classic Series to use any photos taken during the show to be used for promotional purposes on social media, print or video. I accept and acknowledge that Equine activities are inherently dangerous and could at any moment succumb to natural instincts which could cause harm physically, mentally or emotionally to myself or others and in no way will I hold the above mentioned parties responsible or liable. I understand that anyone riding, handling, working with, or near an equine can suffer bodily or other injuries.

Equines are unpredictable by nature. I know that equines can do any of these things at any time without warning, regardless of the horse's experience or training level. I also understand that all equines, even if they have no history of inflicting injury, are powerful and have the potential to be dangerous to those who are on, near, or around them.
