Dennis Colbert is a native of Lewistown, Illinois, where he earned nine varsity letters for the Indians in three sports: baseball, basketball and football. He went on to earn a Bachelor's Degree in Education with a major in Math at Illinois State University before attaining a Masters Degree in Mathematics from the University of Illinois.

Armed with those degrees, Dennis became a high school and junior college teacher and basketball and football coach in south suburban Chicago and Peoria, Illinois; but after four years and with a wife and young son, he decided he needed a more lucrative occupation. He entered a training program with Caterpillar, Inc. which is headquartered in Peoria. This became the beginning of a rewarding thirty-five year career with that company.
