DESCRIPTION OF MCT MASTER DEGREE PROGRAM

Purpose

The Master Degree Program is designed to produce competent Bible expositors who are qualified to serve God effectively as pastors, missionaries or leaders in other areas of vocational Christian ministry.

Goals

Educational Goals

To enable students to verbalize a general knowledge of the Bible, including a synthetic understanding of the major books

- Acquire and demonstrate an understanding of the historical development of theology and an ability to support their theological views and apply them to contemporary issues.
- Acquire and demonstrate an ability to exegete the Hebrew and Greek texts of the Bible.
- Acquire and demonstrate an understanding of the educational program of the local church and awareness of the worldwide mission of the church.

Spiritual Goal

To enable students to acquire and demonstrate an increasing likeness to Christ as manifested in love for God, love for others, and the fruit of the Spirit.

Ministry Goals

To enable students to:

- Communicate the Bible effectively.
- Demonstrate skills in various ministries.
- Lead a local church or other group by means of biblical exposition, leadership skills, evangelism, and service.
- **The first year of this program you will receive a Master in Christian Ministry degree, which is a pre-requisite of the Master's Program.**

- **Students will choose their degree concentration from the following degrees:**
 - **Biblical Studies**
 - **Theology**
 - **Christian Ministry**
 - **Divinity**
 - **Biblical Counseling**

If a student chooses Christian Ministry or Divinity, there will be Home Study Tracking Courses that the students will complete at home. These Track Courses will focus their pursuit of their concentrated course of study. Students will take one tracking course per year. Biblical Studies and Theology will not require additional courses.
