On November 1, at 11:15pm, Officer Robert Schlossberg, was patrolling Russell Avenue when he observed a vehicle in front of him commit several motor vehicle violations. Officer Schlossberg stopped the vehicle on Wyckoff Avenue. Subsequent investigation led to the arrest of Daniel P Burri, Mahwah, age: 32. Mr Burri was charged with possession of cds, possession of cds in a motor vehicle and failure to maintain a traffic lane. He was released and is scheduled to appear in court. Sergeant Daniel Kellogg and Officer Kyle Ferreira assisted.

On November 5, at 10:53am, Officer Joseph Fullam was conducting traffic enforcement on Route 208 North. Officer Fullam observed a vehicle pass his location with an equipment violation. Officer Fullam stopped the vehicle and as he was speaking with the driver, he detected the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. Subsequent investigation led to the arrest of Adelso Remigio, Haverstraw, NY, age: 29. Mr Remigio was charged with possession of marijuana, possession of cds in a motor vehicle, unclear license plate and failure to produce a registration card. He was released and is scheduled to appear in court. Sergeant Thomas Tully and Sergeant Mark Tagliareni assisted.
