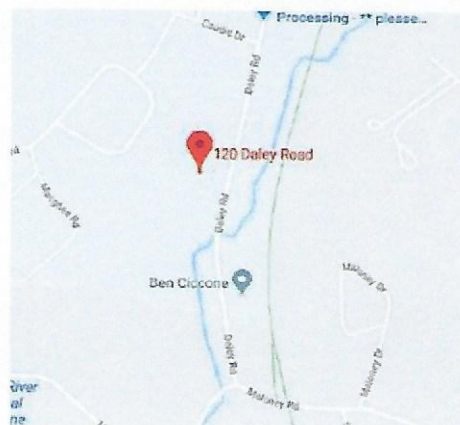

There will be 3 rounds of black powder target shooting from 25 yards.

Each round will consist of 10 shooters.

Fee is \$5.00 per round per shooter. Shooters may compete once in each of the 3 rounds.

The most accurate shooter to the target in each round will win \$10.00 and will compete in the final for no extra fee.

1<sup>st</sup> Prize - \$50.00 plus 200 lead balls (choice of .45, .50, or .54 caliber) & Trophy

2<sup>nd</sup> Prize - \$25.00 plus 100 lead balls (choice of .45, .50, or .54 caliber)

3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - 100 lead balls (choice of .45, .50, or .54 caliber)

Hamburgers, hot dogs, chips, soda and water will be on sale all day.

There will be a tomahawk throwing area to try as well as primitive mountain man camps for viewing.

Period correct dress is encouraged but not required. An award will be given for best period correct dress.

There will be door prizes and a 50/50 raffle for \$1.00 per ticket.

#### Rules and requirements:

Rifles must be muzzle loaders or inline. Flint lock or percussion cap. Black powder or Pyrodex may be used. Open sights only. One shot off hand per round from the 25 yard line. Closest to the center of target wins. In the event of a tie there will be a shoot off between the shooters to determine the round winner and advance to the final. Shooters to supply their own rifles, supplies, balls, powder, etc. HVSA will supply the targets. The competition is open to shooters 16 years of age and up. However, shooters between the ages of 16 to 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. A waiver of liability must be signed in order to compete.
