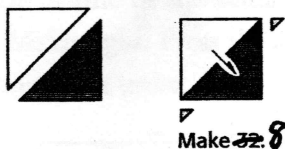


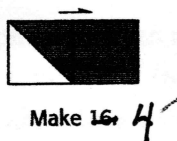
Supernova 10 1/2" Finished Block

Piecing the Blocks

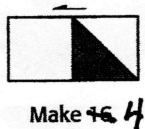
1. Sew a light triangle to each dark triangle to make a triangle square. Make ~~8~~⁴. Press the seams toward the dark triangles. Trim the dog-ears. The triangle squares should measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".



2. Sew a triangle square to each dark 2 1/2" square as shown. Make ~~16~~⁴. Press the seam toward the dark square.



3. Sew the remaining triangle squares to each light 2 1/2" square as shown. Make ~~16~~⁴. Press the seam toward the light square.



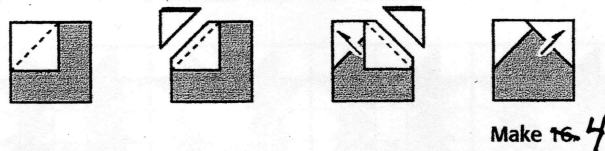
4. Join the units from steps 2 and 3 as shown to make ~~16~~⁴ outer-star-point units. Press the seams toward the dark-square units. The units should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



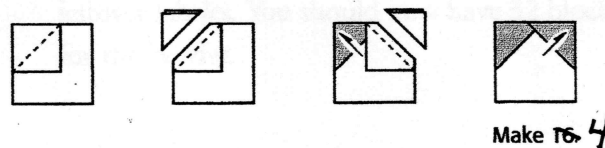
5. Use a sharp pencil or fabric marking pen to draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the light and accent 1 1/2" squares.

Accent fabric
 4 - 2.5" squares
 8 - 1.5" squares

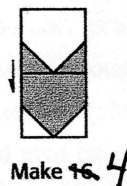
6. Place a light 1 1/2" square on one corner of an accent 2 1/2" square as shown, right sides together. Stitch on the marked line. Trim 1/4" from the stitching line. Press the seam toward the triangle. Repeat on the opposite corner to complete an inner-star-point unit. Make ~~16~~⁴.



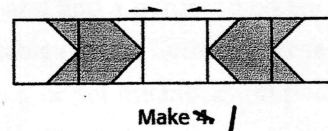
7. Repeat step 6 with the accent 1 1/2" squares and the light 2 1/2" squares to make the middle-star-point units.



8. Sew each inner-star-point unit to a middle-star-point unit as shown. Make ~~16~~⁴. Press the seams toward the inner-star-point units.



9. Sew a unit from step 8 to each side of a light 2 1/2" square to make the block center row. Make ~~four~~¹. Press the seams toward the square.



Cutting:

Light fabric - 9 - 2.5" squares
 8 - 1.5" x 1.5" squares
 4 - 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares

Dark fabric - 4 - 2.5" squares
 4 - 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

Cut all 2 7/8" squares in half diagonally to make 4 light triangles & 4 dark ones.
