- 4. Old Business:

Stop the Bleed layperson kits with instructions are now ready to be distributed to Northcentral, Midstate & Nicolet Technical Schools for inclusion in their AED cabinets. Dr. Gordon, Corey Smith & Dana Baumgartner have volunteered to distribute the kits. Final contents of the kit are SWAT-T tourniquet, 4 4x4 gauze pads, one roll gauze, Coban tape roll & one pair of nitrile gloves. Future sites for distribution will be discussed at later meetings.

A MABAS based system for EMS in mass disaster situations were discussed. Only 6 of the NCRTAC counties have been surveyed as to their familiarity with MABAS. Before the next meeting the additional counties will be contacted. A contact person for each 911 dispatch center will be obtained. The necessity for contacting the many small EMS providers with just 1 ambulance & limited number of providers is essential to make the system complete. Educational

opportunities will be needed for small services & 911 centers not using MABAS already. Dr. Clark felt that inclusion of agreements with other providers to cover 911 calls in disaster situations could be addressed in State Operational Plans in sections addressing Mutual Aid agreements.

- 5. New Business: Michael Fraley reported that other RTACs are looking at layperson educational presentations to promote bleeding control for injuries in their communities. This topic will be included on future OOH agendas.
