



HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM

ADMIINISTRATIVE PLAN

GALESBURG, IL, 11/01/2018: The Knox County Housing Authority (KCHA) is revising its Housing Choice Voucher Program Administrative Plan. The purpose of the administrative plan is to establish policies for carrying out the Housing Choice Voucher Program in a manner consistent with HUD requirements and local goals and objectives contained in the PHA's agency plan. This administrative plan is a supporting document to the PHA agency plan.

The Administrative Plan is required by HUD and it must be available for public review. CFR 24 Part 903.17 requires a public housing authority to "Make the proposed PHA plan(s), the required attachments and documents related to the plans, and all relevant information available for inspection by the public at the principal office of the PHA during normal business hours; and to publish a notice informing the public that the information is available for review and inspection, and that a public hearing will take place on the plan, and the date, time and location of the hearing."
