# Western Washington Shop Hop 2023



Quilt blocks from the following shops are shown in the photograph, reading left to right, top to bottom: Top Border corners: Casey's Crafts; Just for Funl Quilting.

1st row: Creative Union Fabrics; A Plus Sewing; Tangled Threads Quilt Store; Quilted Strait; Gee Gee's Quilting; Annie's Quilt Shoppe.

2nd row: Quilting Mayhem; Stitches Quilt and Craft; Fiddlesticks Quilt Shop; Carriage Country Quilts; Pieced Together Quilts; Sister's Quilt Shop.

3rd row: Sew Hip; Quilters Workshop; All Things Sew; Ben Franklin Crafts – Monroe; Front Porch Quilts; The Quilt Barn. 4th row: Paisley Duck; A Stitch in Time Quilt Shoppe; Ben Franklin Crafts – Bonney Lake; Calico Country; Bigfoot Quilts; Esther's Fabrics,

6th row: The Enchanted Rose Emporium; Heavenly Quilts and Fabrics Redeemed; Quilted Treasures Studio; The Quilting Fairy; Kori's Fabric Creations; Calico Creations.

Bottom Border corners: Knotty Stitches; Shibori Dragon.

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## Instructions for finishing the Shop Hop 2023 Quilt (as shown on poster).

40 Shop Hop blocks are used in this quilt. Finished quilt size: 75" x 75" • Finished block size: 8" x 8"

### <u>Materials</u>

(Yardages are based on 40" usable fabric width, after prewashing fabric and trimming selvages.)

- 1% yds. Shop Hop 2023 dark blue swirls (Y3901-30) for sashing rectangles
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yd. Shop Hop 2023 white diagonal stripe (Y3899-1) for cornerstones

1 % yds. Shop Hop 2023 border (232SH-1) for border ¾ yd. for binding [The Shop Hop 2023 pool yarn

fabric (Y3900-124) was used for the poster quilt.] 5 yds. for backing

#### Cutting

From Shop Hop 2023 dark blue swirls, cut:

• 84 rectangles, 2" x 8½", for sashing rectangles

From Shop Hop 2023 white diagonal stripe, cut:

• 49 squares, 2" x 2", for cornerstones

From Shop Hop 2023 border, cut:


• 4 strips, 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x length of fabric, for borders (These are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)

From binding fabric, cut:

• 8 strips, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 40", for double-fold binding

## Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Sew sashing rectangles and cornerstones, and sashing rectangles and Shop Hop blocks, together in horizontal rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram; then join horizontal rows together. Press all seams toward sashing rectangles.
- Measure width of quilt top through center. Trim 2 border strips to this measurement. Sew a corner block to each end of both strips as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward border strips.
- 3. Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim the remaining 2 border strips to this measurement and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

4. Sew borders, made in Step 2, to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

#### **Finishing**

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.

This year 7 coordinating prints were designed especially for the Western Washington Quilt Shop Hop. The Shop Hop 2023 border print and a coordinating boats and waves print were designed by In The Beginning Fabrics. Five coordinating Shop Hop 2023 go-with prints (including the dark blue swirls and white diagonal stripe) were designed by Clothworks. Look for all of these prints at your favorite quilt shop!
