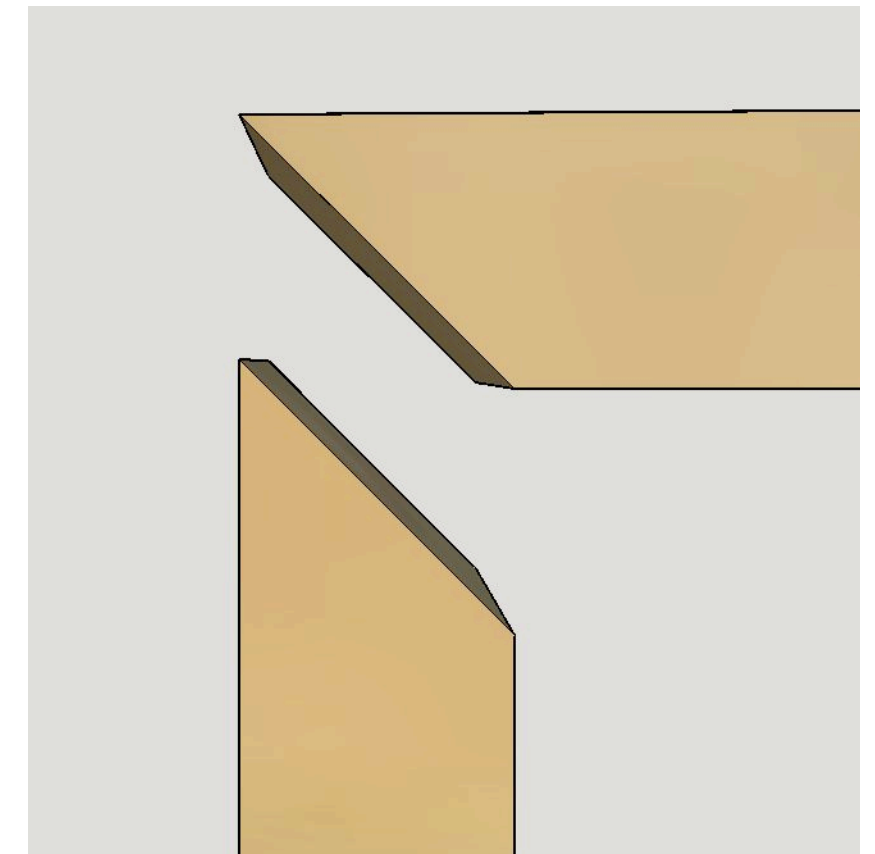
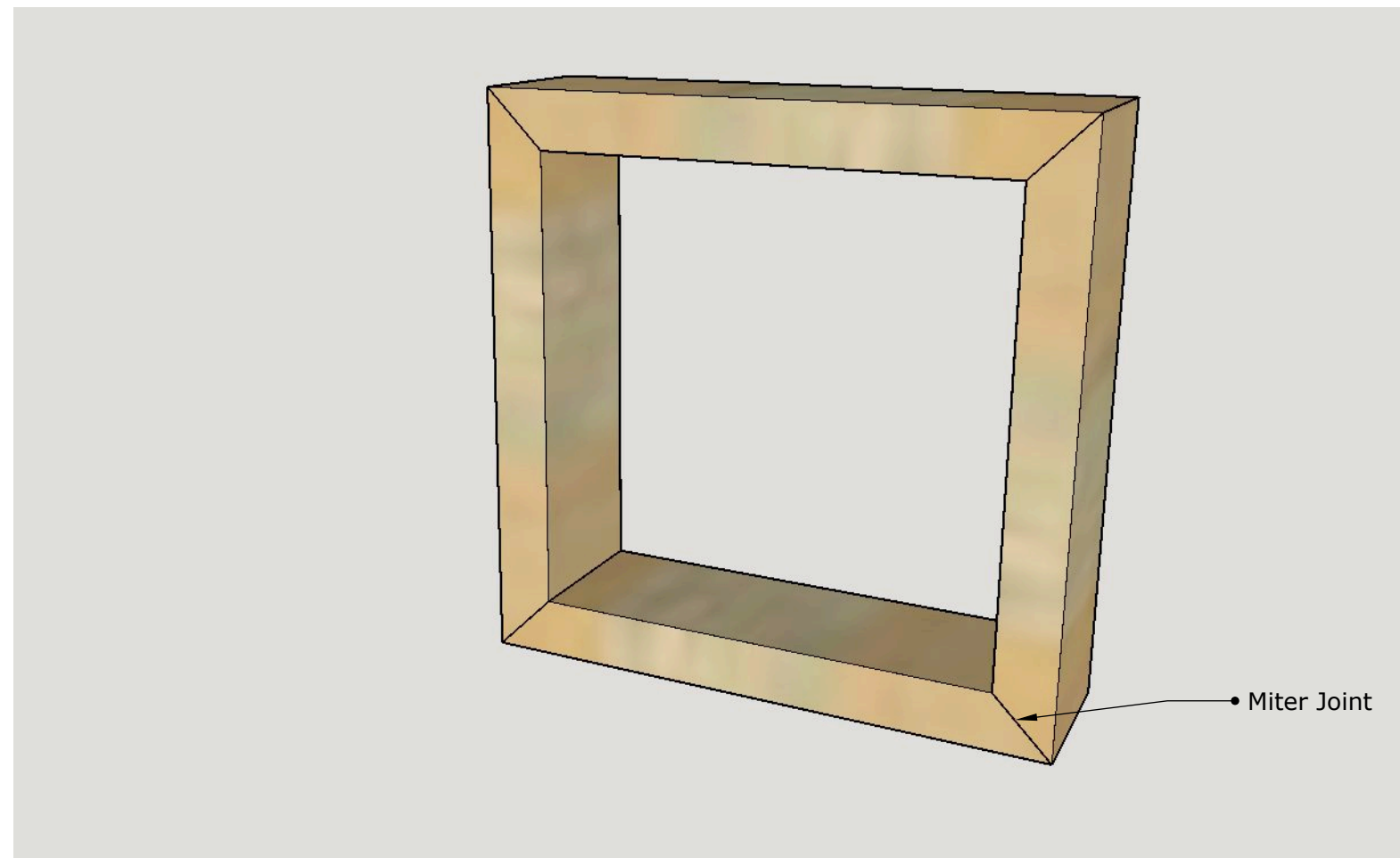


## Miter Joints



A miter Joint is where the ends of two pieces of wood are joined together at a corner, and each edge of the wood is cut at 45 degrees

A Miter Joint is used in products such as picture frames, facing of a carcass but rarely used in furniture where strength is necessary.

A Miter joint is an aesthetic joint because it doesn't show the end grain of the wood which is less attractive than the grain.
