- **THESE WARNING SIGNS** identify the product transported in the line.
- **THEY ALSO** provide the name and number of the operator to call in an emergency.

CALL 911 IF YOU...

SEE: Dead or discolored vegetation amid healthy plants. Dirt being blown, or appearing thrown into the air. Fire or explosion near or involving the pipeline. Exposed pipeline, caused by a flood, landslide, or by any mechanical or digging machinery.

HEAR: A hissing, whistling, or roaring sound.

SMELL: An unusual order, or strong oil smell, near the pipeline.
