McNeilus Changes Forms

Effective November 1st McNeilus has updated their Pre-Trip Inspection form and the Delivery Inspection form.

In each driver packet you will find an information sheet –*PLEASE* review it carefully.

AAT receives a "report card" each month from McNeilus that outlines each inspection form that is turned in along with other items. If there is missing information such as the odometer, date, drivers name, signature or putting unapproved notes on the inspection forms; these are all documented as errors and negatively impacts our performance report card.

Reminder

Sleeping in vehicles is prohibited. This is against DOT regulations and a serious offense. During an inspection they may ask you to provide receipts for your lodging for log compliance.

Winter Gear

Winter Tire Socks

Last year AAT switched over completely to using the tire socks vs chains. Driver feedback was great as they are so much easier to handle and transport.

Most airlines allow a carry on and one personal item which the sock bag will easily qualify for.

If you are on a "puddle-jumper" flight where your bags cannot be checked, they may fit in your carry-on bag.

The value of each set of tire socks is \$385.00. Drivers are subject to the full replacement cost if not returned to AAT.
