This position will fulfill the following duties:

1. Serve as the Company representative to the Client as a Teaming Partner;
2. Maintain primary leadership of projects from start to finish, with exceptional communication and coordination with the Client, Project Manager and Subcontractors;
3. Provide Tier 1 Health & Safety environment to the project, peers and Client;
4. Have complete understanding of the Client contract, subcontracts to vendors, schedule milestones, and cost awareness;
5. Understand project specifications, drawings, change in scopes, etc.;
6. Directly coordinate with the Project Manager and produce project work plans, scopes, tasks and adapt to project changes;
7. Have complete understanding of subcontractor and vendor tiers, and associated responsibilities and obligations tied to these team members;
8. Chair weekly meetings for internal Project goals, as well as progress meetings for Client and organizational meeting with Subcontractors;
9. Actively coordinate with Project Manager financial records, budgets, changes, adaptations;
10. Being well documented in project details, cost management practices with accounting requirements.
11. Plan and prepare for future projects (working out of the Lexington, KY office) when not on assignment.

This is a full time, salary position located in Lexington, KY. The successful individual does not need to be located in Lexington, KY but will be expected to work out of the Lexington, KY office while not assigned to a project.
