2020 Offense/Defense Analysis

Former UNLV head coach Tony Sanchez left the program in much better shape that what he inherited. The Rebels recently opened a \$35 million football complex and they will now play their home games in the new \$1.8 billion Raiders stadium. Those selling points weren't lost on the 2020 recruits as new head coach Marcus Arroyo (Oregon O.C. last 3 years) signed one of the best classes in UNLV history in February.

Arroyo inherits a lot of experience and talent especially at the offensive skill positions. QB Kenyon Oblad (18-9 ratio) is back after taking over the starting job mid-way through last year. He proved to be a much better passer than Ar mani Rogers (2017-18 starter). The Rebels have one the nation's most underrated RB's in Charles Williams (1,257 rush yards and 11 TD's). Former USC WR Randal Grimes (7 TD's) also returns along with their other top 3 receivers

The defense which was a constant area of concern under Sanchez loses most of their best players including CB Jericho Flowers (4 INT's, 2nd-team All-Mountain West). Note that OLB Brennon Scott is the highest-rated recruit to sign with the Rebels since 2006. He could play right away.

The schedule is another area of concern for the Rebels in 2020. While their home schedule is attractive to fans that includes visits from Pac-12 teams California and Arizona St, we currently project the Rebels to be underdogs in all 12 games in 2020.
