BASIC HOUSE DESCRIPTION

GRIFFIN AREA HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Normally Griffin Area Habitat for Humanity builds a three bedroom, two full bathroom house.

The house is total electric, with heat and air conditioning.

The bathroom and utility room floors are tile. The remaining floors are Laminate. The potential homeowner will be allowed to pick all colors for the interior and exterior.

The exterior will be Hardie Plank Siding and 30 year shingles for the roof.

SWEAT EQUITY POLICY

GRIFFIN AREA HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

If you are selected for a Habitat Home, you must work Three Hundred (300) hours. Of the 300 sweat equity hours you will be required to work One Hundred and Fifty (150) hours on your Habitat Home. If there is another Habitat home being built, you will be required to work Fifty (50) hours on that home. If there are no other Habitat homes being built, those 50 hours will have to be used on your home for a total of Two Hundred Hours (200). The other One Hundred (100) hours can be completed by family or friends. You are responsible to make sure you get the proper credit for all “sweat equity” hours. Make sure the hours are logged in your hourly log and Habitat’s Log book

EXAMPLES OF HOURS FOR FAMILY/FRIENDS

You need a babysitter so you can work.

Your Church, company or friend provides lunch.

Family/Friends work on the house, but when they come on the work site they must tell a Habitat Supervisor they are working for you.

SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY CHECK POLICY

GRIFFIN AREA HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

As a ministry, Griffin Area Habitat for Humanity values the safety of children, volunteers, and the families we serve.

Griffin Area Habitat for Humanity requires that sex offender registry checks be conducted for all potential partner families. Griffin Area Habitat for Humanity reserves the right to recheck sex offender status at any time during the homebuilding process.

Any person who does not consent to a sex offender registry check will not be permitted to become a partner family.

Any applicant that is found on the sex offender registry will not be considered for a partner family with Griffin Area Habitat for Humanity.

DESELECTION POLICY

GRIFFIN AREA HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Demonstrated fraud on the application.

Failure to complete requirements set forth in homeowners' agreement. I.e. lack of willingness to partner.

Presence on a sex offender data base that disqualifies an approved applicant from the homeowner program.

Negative change in financial condition that significantly affects the ability to pay.
