Municipal Officers' Notice of Public Hearing on Secret Ballot Referendum

The Municipal Officers of the Town of Bridgton will hold a Public Hearing at 6:00 P.M. on Tuesday, October 25, 2016 at the Municipal Building located at 10 Iredale Street, in Bridgton to hear public comment on the following questions that will be presented to the voters via referendum ballot on November 8, 2016:

Question 1. (BY CITIZEN'S PETITION) "No person shall sell, use, display or cause to be exploded consumer fireworks in the Town of Bridgton, ME 04009 This will not include any fireworks display approved by the state fire marshal This does not apply to anyone issued a fireworks display permit by the state of Maine pursuant to 8 M.R.S.A. § 227-A-"

Question 2. (BY CITIZEN'S PETITION) "Should the Bridgton Farmers Market be allowed to set up on the green on Depot St. beginning May 2017?"
