Corky Hancock Memorial Scholarship

The John "Corky" Hancock Memorial Scholarship was founded in 2015, to perpetuate the memory of a businessman, philanthropist and respected member of the Downriver Community who believed hard work should be recognized and rewarded. Corky was a kind and generous man and an ardent supporter of the downriver community.

The Corky Hancock Memorial Scholarship foundation is a 501c3 organization that began its partnership with the Downriver Career Technical Consortium (DCTC) in 2016. An annual fundraiser is hosted by the foundation to assist in funding Corky's legacy. We have made it our mission to increase awareness of alternative career paths for our students. The first year, the foundation awarded three \$2000 scholarships to three deserving seniors to further their education in skilled trades. Last year four \$2000 scholarships were awarded.

The scholarship is given annually to DCTC students who wish to further their education in career technical education programs in the skilled trades such as, welding, drafting, CAD, aviation technology and robotics. It can be applied to a post-secondary institution, apprenticeship program or highly specialized post-secondary trade or technical school.

Applications are available through your high school career technical education instructor or through your counseling department.

Completed application

- Essay (typed)
- Copy of transcript
- Acceptance letter to a post-secondary institution, program or apprenticeship

Applicants may be asked to interview with the scholarship committee. Applications are rated on academics, technical skills, a written essay and an interview.
