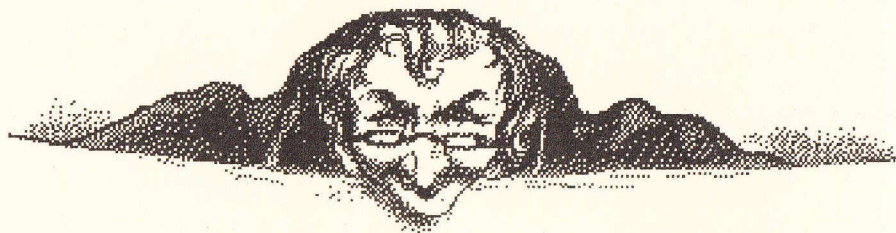

Wednesday Handicap League

This fall, we are experimenting with two things. The first is the tracking of individual PPD (Point Per Dart) averages in 501 singles matches. We then took this average and applied it to all games involved in a dart match for the Wednesday Handicap (Yellow) Division. The results are: (so far)

1. It's a hell of a lot of work to get the averages recalculated and standings out each week before the next match.
 2. PPD tracking may be in the future of all DDA players.
 3. Handicapping may or may not be in the future. We need to work out a fast reporting system.
